1. Doha's Hamad International Airport Crowned World's Best in 2024 Skytrax Awards (April 22, 2024)

Hamad International Airport (HIA) in Doha, Qatar, clinched the title of World's Best Airport in the 2024 Skytrax World Airport Awards.

An Overview of the News

- **Singapore Changi Airport**, previous winner of the 2023 Airport of the Year award, **secured 2nd place** overall and was recognized as the Best Airport in Asia. It also won the **accolade for the World's Best Airport Immigration Service**.
- **Incheon Airport in Seoul, South Korea**, ranked **3rd globally** and was honored with the title of **World's Most Family Friendly Airport for 2024**.
- The awards ceremony took place at the **Passenger Terminal EXPO** in **Frankfurt, Germany**, on **April 17th, 2024**.
- Skytrax, an international aviation research organization **headquartered** in **London, United Kingdom (UK)**, organizes the prestigious World Airport Awards.

- India women's hockey team forward Deepika Soreng expressed her gratitude to Hockey India on April 16, 2024.
- In 2023, Deepika made her debut for the team in the Women's Junior Asia Cup.
- She contributed significantly to the team's success, scoring 7 goals in 6 matches to help them clinch the gold medal, and emerged as the team's second-highest goalscorer.

5. Israeli Mathematician Avi Wigderson Wins 2023 ACM Turing Award (April 14, 2024)

Avi Wigderson, an Israeli mathematician and computer scientist, was awarded the 2023 ACM A.M. Turing Award.

An Overview of the News

- This award is widely regarded as the "Nobel Prize of Computing".
- He holds the position of Herbert H. Maass Professor in the School of Mathematics at the Institute for Advanced Study (IAS) in Princeton, New Jersey, USA.

Reason for Award:

- Wigderson was honored for his foundational contributions to the theory of computation.
- His work significantly influenced the understanding of randomness in computation and mathematics.
- He was recognized for his intellectual leadership in theoretical computer science.
- The ACM A.M. Turing Award carries a prestigious cash prize of USD 1 million.

Contributions and Career Highlights:

- In 1986, Wigderson began his academic career as a Senior Lecturer in the Department of Computer Science at the Hebrew University in Jerusalem, Israel.

- He was promoted to Associate Professor in 1987 and later became a full Professor at the Computer Science Institute of the Hebrew University.
- In 1993, he assumed the role of Chairman of the Computer Science Institute at Hebrew University.
- In 1999, he joined the faculty as a Professor at the Institute for Advanced Study (IAS) in Princeton, New Jersey.

6. Gagandeep Kang becomes first Indian woman to win 2024 Canada Gairdner Global Health Award (April 13, 2024)

On April 11, 2024, Gagandeep Kang, an Indian microbiologist and virologist, received the prestigious John Dirks Canada Gairdner Global Health Award from the Toronto-based Gairdner Foundation.

An Overview of the News

- Kang is the first Indian woman to be bestowed with this honor.
- Kang's recognition stemmed from her extensive cohort-based epidemiological, environmental, and clinical trial research on enteric diseases in children.
- Her work has had a significant impact on vaccine development and health policy in India and globally.

Background of Gagandeep Kang

- Kang serves as an adjunct professor at the Christian Medical College (CMC) in Vellore, Tamil Nadu.
- Additionally, she holds the position of Director of enteric diagnostics, genomics, and epidemiology at the Bill and Melinda Gates Foundation.
- Kang's contributions include playing a pivotal role in the development and introduction of two Indian rotavirus vaccines, Rotavac and Rotasiil, into the National Immunisation Program.

John Dirks Canada Gairdner Global Health Award

- This award is presented annually to researchers who have utilized rational, scientifically based research to improve the health and well-being of populations facing health inequities globally.

About the Canada Gairdner Awards

- Established in 1957 with a donation from philanthropist James A. Gairdner, the Gairdner Foundation is a non-profit organization that acknowledges outstanding achievements in biomedical research worldwide.
- The Canada Gairdner Awards have been presented annually since 1957 by the Gairdner Foundation.

Recipients of these awards receive CDN 100,000 each along with a medal.

7. National Maritime Day 2024: Sagar Samman Awards and Recognition (April 11, 2024)

Ministry of Ports, Shipping and Waterways (MOPSW) celebrated the 61st National Maritime Day (5 April 2024) with awards and recognition in the maritime sector.

An Overview of the News

- The event was held at the Yashwantrao Chavan Centre, Nariman Point, Mumbai, Maharashtra, organized by the National Maritime Day Celebrations (NMDC) Central Committee.
- Theme of the event: "Sustainable Shipping: Opportunities and Challenges."

8. Chandrayaan-3 Mission Team Wins 2024 John L "Jack" Swigert Jr. Award (April 10, 2024)

The Chandrayaan-3 mission team of the Indian Space Research Organisation (ISRO) was awarded the 2024 John L "Jack" Swigert Jr. award for Space Exploration.

An Overview of the News

- The award was received by i.DC Manjunath, Consul General of India (CGI) in Houston, United States of America (U.S.A.), on behalf of ISRO's Chandrayaan-3 team.
- The award ceremony took place on 8th April, 2024, during the Opening Ceremony of the annual Space Symposium organized by Space Foundations in Colorado, U.S.A.

- Chandrayaan-3 mission was announced as the recipient of the 2024 John L "Jack" Swigert Jr. award for space exploration by Space Foundation in January 2024.

Other Winners:

- Included teams from NASA, such as OSIRIS-REx, Mars Ingenuity Helicopter, Insight-Mars Cube One, and Dawn and Cassini missions.

About Chandrayaan-3 Mission:

- Launched on 14th July, 2023, from Satish Dhawan Space Centre in Sriharikota, Andhra Pradesh (A.P.).
- The lander module successfully touched down on the moon on 23rd August, 2023.
- Consists of a lunar lander named "Vikram" and a lunar rover named "Pragyan."

About John L "Jack" Swigert Jr. Award for Space Exploration:

- Established in 2004 in honor of former NASA astronaut John L. "Jack" Swigert Jr. by Space Foundation.
- Recognizes significant achievements in space exploration.
- Presented annually at the Space Symposium by the Space Foundation, a non-profit organization founded in 1983.

10. Avantika Vandanapu Named 'South Asian Person of the Year' at Harvard University (April 12, 2024)

Avantika Vandanapu was honored as the 'South Asian Person of the Year' by the South Asian Association (SAA) at Harvard University on April 9, 2024.

- She was recognized for her remarkable achievements and significant impact in both the international and Indian entertainment industries.
