1. RBI releases web publication entitled 'Statistical Tables relating to Banks in India: 2021-22' (Dec. 28, 2022)

Statistical Tables relating to Banks in India: 2021-22'

The Reserve Bank released its web publication entitled '**Statistical Tables relating to Banks in India: 2021-22**' covering the activities of the **Indian banking sector** on 27 December.

Important facts

- The publication presents entity-wise information on major items of liabilities and assets along with their maturity profile, income and expenses, select financial ratios, number of employees, and details of priority sector advances for scheduled commercial banks excluding regional rural banks.
- In addition, capital-to-risk-weighted asset ratios, non-performing assets, exposure to sensitive sectors, contingent liabilities, and unclaimed deposits are included.
- State-wise distribution of consolidated balance sheet of rural cooperative banks are also presented.

- Shane Watson is an Australian former international cricketer. He has been a right-handed batsman and a right-arm medium-fast swing bowler.
- He played international cricket between 2002 and 2016.

- He was the world's No. 1 T20I all-rounder for a record 150 weeks.
- Shane Watson was born on 17 June 1981 in Ipswich, Queensland, Australia. At the age of 21, he made his international debut on 24 March 2002, playing an ODI against South Africa at Centurion.
- In his ODI career, he scored 5757 runs in 190 matches at an average of 40.54 and took 168 wickets.
- Watson played the first Test match of his career on 2 January 2005 against Pakistan in Sydney.
- Watson holds many records in T20I, ODI and T20. According to Forbes, Watson was the highest paid non-Indian cricketer in the world for five consecutive years between 2011 and 2015.
- On 2 November 2020, he announced his retirement from all forms of cricket.
- In 2017, Watson launched Let's Activate, a sports clinic for children. Watson has his own podcast called Lessons Learned with the Greats.

5. Union Minister Rajiv Chandrashekhar releases two books on PM Modi in Dubai (Nov. 7, 2022)

- Dara Shikoh was the eldest son of Mughal Emperor Shah Jahan and was defeated by Aurangzeb in the succession struggle .He was later executed by Aurangzeb in 1659.
