1. 14th December: National Energy Conservation Day (Dec. 14, 2021)

2021 Theme: "Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav: Energy Efficient India" and "Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav: Cleaner Planet"

- In 2021: Under Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav, the Ministry of Power celebrates **Energy Conservation Week from 8th to 14th** December 2021. Various activities have been undertaken by Power CPSUs as part of the celebrations.
- In India, National Energy Conservation Day is observed every year on 14th December to raise awareness about the significance of energy and the need of conserving energy by using less energy.
- On this day, National Energy Conservation Awards are given away to honour innovation and accomplishments in energy conservation by industries, buildings, and manufacturers of BEE(Bureau of Energy Efficiency) star labelled appliances, as well as raise awareness that energy conservation is an important part of India's response to reducing global warming.

2. International Universal Health Coverage Day (Dec. 12, 2021)

International Universal Health Coverage Day

- On 12 December 2017, the United Nations proclaimed 12 December as International Universal Health Coverage Day.
- Theme of the International Universal Health Coverage Day 2021 : Leave No One Behind When It Comes to Health: Invest in Health Systems for All"
- International Universal Health Coverage Day aims to raise awareness of the need for strong and resilient health systems and universal health coverage with multi-stakeholder partners.

3. 11th December: International Mountain Day (Dec. 11, 2021)

2021 Theme: "Sustainable Mountain Tourism."

International Mountain Day is celebrated annually on **December 11**, to promote awareness for mountain communities around the globe. December 11th was officially declared as International Mountain Day by the **United Nations General Assembly Resolution 57/245 in December 2002.**

• Sustainable tourism in mountains can be seen as a contribution to creating additional and alternative livelihood options and promoting poverty alleviation, social inclusion, in addition to landscape and biodiversity conservation.

Importance of mountains

According to the UN, mountains are home to 15 percent of the global population and they provide fresh water for daily life to half of humanity. Mountains also host about half of the biodiversity hotspots across the world.

4. 10th December: Human Rights Day (Dec. 10, 2021)

2021 Theme: "EQUALITY - Reducing inequalities, advancing human rights."

Human Rights Day (also called HRD) is observed every year on 10 December - the day on which the United Nations General Assembly adopted, in 1948, the Universal Declaration of Human Rights.

Human Rights

Human rights include the **right to life and liberty**, **freedom from slavery** and **torture**, **freedom of opinion and expression**, the **right to work and education**, and many more. Everyone is entitled to these rights, without discrimination.

5. 9th December- International Anti-Corruption Day (Dec. 9, 2021)

The International Anti-Corruption Day is observed globally on 9th December every year to raise awareness of corruption and of the role of the convention in combating and presenting it. Theme for 2021 is, **"Your right, your role: say no to corruption.**"

- The United Nations General Assembly on 31st October, 2003, adopted the United Nations Convention against Corruption, and designated December 9 as International Anti-Corruption Day, in order to raise awareness about corruption and of the role of Convention in fighting and preventing it.
- The convention came into force in the year 2005, and since then the day is being observed annually.

6. Armed Forces Flag Day (Dec. 7, 2021)

Since 1949, 7th December is observed as the Armed Forces Flag Day throughout the country to honour the martyrs and the men in uniform who valiantly fought & continue to fight on our borders to safeguard the country's honour.

7. 7 December: International Civil Aviation Day (Dec. 7, 2021)

The theme for International Civil Aviation Day 2021 is **"Advancing Innovation for Global Aviation Development."**

The first celebration of International Civil Aviation was held in the year 1994

8. 6th December: Mahaparinirvan Divas (Dec. 6, 2021)

India observes **December 6 as Mahaparinirvan Divas** every year to mark the death anniversary of **Dr Bhimrao Ramji Ambedkar**, who fought for economic and social empowerment of Dalits in the country.

9. World Soil Day (Dec. 5, 2021)

This year, the theme of World Soil Day 2021 is 'Halt soil salinization, boost soil productivity' with a motive to raise awareness of the importance of maintaining healthy ecosystems and human well-being.

The Food and Agriculture Organisation (FAO) Conference, in June 2013, urged the UN General Assembly.to adopt the World Soil Day. The UN General Assembly finally designated December 5, 2014, as the first official World Soil Day.

10. Indian Navy Day, 4th December (Dec. 4, 2021)

Indian Navy Day is celebrated every year on December 4 to commemorate the attack on the Karachi harbour during the India-Pakistan war 1971 under operation Trident.

Operation Trident:

- Operation Trident was an offensive operation launched by the Indian Navy on the night of 4–5 December on Pakistan's port city of Karachi during the Indo-Pakistani War of 1971.
- Operation Trident saw the first use of anti-ship missiles in combat in the region and inflicted heavy damage on Pakistani vessels and facilities .
