1. Himachal Pradesh wins its maiden Vijay Hazare title (Dec. 27, 2021)

- Himachal Pradesh won its first Vijay Hazare by trophy defeating Tamilnadu by 11 runs in the final of the Vijay Hazare trophy 2021-22. .
- The final was played at Sawai Man Singh stadium, Jaipur on 26 December 2021.
- Vijay Hazare is the premier 50-50 overs over domestic cricket tournament..

2. Moyuka Uchijima of Japan wins ITF women Tennis tournament (Dec. 26, 2021)

- Unseeded Moyuka Uchijima of Japan beat fourth seed Diana Marcinkevica of Latvia 6-2, 7-5 in the final of the NECC \$25,000 ITF women's tennis tournament.
- It was the fourth title in the professional circuit for Moyuka, and third of the season.
- In the doubles final, top seeds Anna Danilina and Valeriya Strakhova prevailed 6-0, 2-6, 10-5 against the Japanese pair of Funa Kozaki and Misaki Matsuda.
- It was held at the Deccan Gymkhana, Pune.

3. 11th National Junior Boys Hockey Championship (Dec. 26, 2021)

- Uttar Pradesh defeated Chandigarh by a 3-1 margin in the final to win the 11th Hockey India junior National men's championship.
- Odisha defeated Haryana to take the third place.
- The tournament was held at Kovilpatti, in Tamilnadu from 16 to 25 December 2021.

4. Harbhajan Singh retires from cricket (Dec. 25, 2021)

- Off-spinner Harbhajan Singh has announced retirement from all forms of competitive cricket.
- The 41-year-old from Punjab took 417 wickets in 103 Tests, 269 wickets in 236 ODIs and 25 wickets in 28 T20Is in his illustrious career. In the IPL across 13 seasons for Mumbai Indians, Chennai Super Kings, and Kolkata Knight Riders, he took 150 wickets in 163 matches.
- Harbhajan, who made his India debut during an ODI against New Zealand at Sharjah in 1998, last played for the country in March, 2016 during a T20I against the UAE at Dhaka.

5. Indians Shine in Asian Junior Chess Championship 2021 (Dec. 24, 2021)

- India's V S Raahul (18) won the boys titles in the Asian Junior chess championship 2021.
- He also earned his first GM-norm.

7. Zverev named Germany's Sportsman of the Year (Dec. 22, 2021)

- He became the first tennis player, since 1991, to win the award.
- The **75th edition of the awards was organized by the Internationale Sport-Korrespondenz (ISK),** a sports journalist agency in Germany.

8. 11th Hockey India Senior Men National Championship (Dec. 22, 2021)
