- It celebrates exceptional reporting that informs the public, amplifies local voices, facilitates critical information dissemination, and holds authority figures accountable.

# **Climate and Labour Film Grant**

- Grant Launch: At the ceremony, Vivienne Francis, Director of One World Media, announced a new grant initiative.
- Purpose: The grant, valued at up to £20,000, aims to fund a documentary produced by a filmmaker from the global south.
- Theme: The documentary will focus on the impacts of climate change on people's lives and labor.

# 5. Karnataka Vikas Grameena Bank (KVGB) Honored with National Award for Atal Pension Yojana Enrolment Excellence ( June 24, 2024 )
