### 5. CR Rao wins International Prize in Statistics 2023 (April 10, 2023)

CR Rao wins International Prize in Statistics 2023

Kalyampudi Radhakrishna Rao, an Indian-American statistician won the 2023 International Prize in Statistics.

### **An Overview of the News**

- Rao will be honoured with the award at the International Statistical Institute's World Statistics Congress in Ottawa, Canada in July.
- The prize will be awarded for Rao's groundbreaking paper, 'The Information and Accuracy Obtained in the Estimation of Statistical Parameters', published in 1945 in the Bulletin of the Calcutta Mathematical Society.
- The paper was later included in the book Breakthroughs in Statistics, 1890-1990.
- The International Prize in Statistics is considered equivalent to the Nobel Prize in Statistics.
- The award recognizes individuals or teams who have made significant contributions to science, technology, and human welfare through the use of statistics.
- Five major international statistical organisations cooperate to award the prize.
- The award carries an **\$80,000** cash prize and is presented once every two years.

#### **About CR Rao**

- He is a renowned statistician and **Emeritus Eberly Professor** in the **Department of Statistics**, **Pennsylvania State University**.
- He was born in **Karnataka** in 1920 and has been associated with the **Indian Statistical Institute in Kolkata** since 1941.
- Rao has been honoured with several awards throughout his career, including the **Padma Bhushan** in 1968 and the **Padma Vibhushan** in 2001.
- He was also the recipient of the **SS Bhatnagar Prize** in 1963 and was elected a **Fellow of the Royal Society** in 1967.

Rao received the **Wilkes Medal of the American Statistical Association** in 1979 and the **US National Medal** of Science in 2002.

# 7. Indian-American physician honoured with young urologist of the year award (April 6, 2023 )

- She is an Associate Professor at **Albert Einstein College of Medicine and Program Director for the Montefiore Urology** residency programme.
- Abraham has been chosen from the **New York region** for her accomplishments and contributions.

- Abraham has done remarkable work for countless students, residents, fellows and junior
- faculty in the New York area and at his institution.
- She is serving as the Chair of the Executive Curriculum Committee for the Albert Einstein College of Medicine.
- She is a member of the Society for Urodynamics, Female Pelvic Medicine, and Urogenital Reconstruction (SUFU) Young Urologists Committee and Social Media Committee.
- The award committee described her as a prolific researcher with clinical research on the impact of social determinants of **pelvic floor health.**

## Young Urologist of the Year Award

- The award was established by **Dr. Michael C. Ost, 2012-2013 AUA Young Urologist Committee (YUC) Chair.**
- The Young Urologist of the Year Award is presented annually to early-career members of the AUA for their progress in their field and commitment to furthering their efforts.

# 8. Sprinter Lashinda Demus was awarded the Olympic gold medal after a decade ( April 1, 2023 )

More than a decade after the 2012 London Games, Lashinda Demus, a sprinter from the United States, was awarded an Olympic gold medal at the age of 40, Czechia's Zuzana Hejnova a silver and Jamaica's Kalisz Spencer a bronze. Medal awarded.

### **An Overview of the News**

- The International Olympic Committee stripped Natalya Antyukh, the original gold medalist in the 400 metres hurdles, of her title due to her involvement in the Russian doping scandal.
- **Antyukh beat Demus** by just 0.07 seconds at the London track.
- Historical evidence recovered from the Moscow testing laboratory database allowed the Athletics Integrity Unit to disqualify Antyukh's results from July 2012 to June 2013.

## **About London Olympics 2012**

- Held in **London, UK** from 27 July to 12 August 2012.
- Over 10,000 athletes from **204 National Olympic Committees (NOCs**) participated and competed in 26 sports.

- The United States topped the medal table with 104 medals, including 46 gold.
- China finished second with 88 medals, including 38 gold.
- Great Britain finished third with 65 medals, including 29 gold.
