1. Kashmir's Aliya Mir honoured with Wildlife Conservation Award 2023 (March 28, 2023)

Wildlife conservationist Aliya Mir was awarded Wildlife Conservation Award by Jammu and Kashmir Lieutenant Governor Manoj Sinha.

An Overview of the News

- The award makes her the **first woman from the Union Territory** to receive it in recognition of her conservation efforts in the area.
- Alia Mir is also the first woman in Kashmir to work for **Wildlife SOS**, a part of the **Wildlife Rescue Team.**

- The Kerala Puraskarangal is a civilian award second only to the prestigious **Padma Awards conferred by the Government of India.**
- The award is given to individuals who have made exceptional contributions in various fields such as literature, art, culture, science, social work and sports.
- There are three categories of the award: **Kerala Jyothi, Kerala Prabha and Kerala Shree, with Kerala Jyothi** being the highest honour.
- The objective of these awards is to recognize the contribution of outstanding individuals from Kerala and to inspire others to strive for excellence in their respective fields.

About Kerala

About SAARC Writers and Literature Foundation (FOSWAL)

- It was established in 1987 as a non-profit organisation with the objective of promoting regional cooperation and cultural exchange among SAARC (South Asian Association for Regional Cooperation) countries through literature and the arts.
- Its founding members were writers and poets from SAARC countries including **India**, **Pakistan**, **Bangladesh**, **Sri Lanka**, **Nepal**, **Bhutan and Maldives**.
- Its **main objective** is to promote peace and understanding among the people of the SAARC region through literature, cultural exchange and dialogue.
- It organises various literary and cultural events, such as **poetry readings, book launches and cultural festivals**, to promote the rich cultural diversity of the SAARC countries and to provide a platform for writers and artists to showcase their work.
- It also provides a forum for writers and scholars to exchange ideas and collaborate on literary and cultural projects that promote regional cooperation and understanding.
- It has been recognized for its efforts to promote regional cooperation and cultural exchange and has received several awards and honours, including the SAARC Literary Prize and the Mother Teresa International Prize for Social Justice.

An overview of the news

- The 74-year-old **Caffarell**i has been awarded the prize for **his contributions to the field of nonlinear partial equations and free-boundary problems in mathematics.**
- Caffarelli was born and raised in Buenos Aires, Argentina, making him the first Abel Prize laureate from South America.
- Currently, he is a professor at the **University of Texas, Austin.**

About Abel Prize

- First awarded in 2003, the Abel prize "recognises pioneering scientific achievements in mathematics".
- It is named after **Norwegian mathematician Niels Henrik Abel (1802-29**), who in his short life made pioneering contributions in a multitude of fields.
- It is often considered to be an equivalent of the Nobel prize.
- The award carries a monetary prize of 7.5 million kronor (about \$720,000) and a glass plaque designed by Norwegian artist Henrik Haugen.
- The prize is awarded by the **Norwegian Academy of Science and Letters** on behalf of the Ministry of Education.

5. Nepali wicketkeeper-batsman Asif Sheikh wins 2022 Christopher Martin-Jenkins Spirit of Cricket Award (March 21, 2023)

An Overview of the News

- The award is presented annually by the Marylebone Cricket Club (MCC), UK in association with the BBC.
- The award was **created in 2013 by the MCC and the BBC** in memory of former MCC President and BBC Test Match Special Commentator **Christopher Martin-Jenkins (CMJ)**, who was passionate about promoting the spirit of the game.
- Sheikh was awarded for his sportsmanship shown in the **men's T20 International between Nepal and Ireland in February 2022**.
- It is the first time in the award's history that the MCC and the BBC have invited public nominations for the award.

- Sheikh's conduct was declared the winning entry.
- Sheikh was also honoured with the ICC Spirit of Cricket Award in January 2022 for his works.

- Eligibility requires a **minimum of 25 years of service** and outstanding contribution to the military community.
- It was instituted on **May 27, 1951** and is considered one of the most prestigious military awards.
- The award recognizes the collective efforts and sacrifices of a unit in defending their country, maintaining peace and order and upholding military values.

About INS Dronacharya

• INS Dronacharya is responsible for training the **Sagar Prahari Bal** and is also the Navy's primary centre for training various nations in the **Indian Ocean Region (IOR).**

10. Oscars 2023: RRR's 'Naatu Naatu' wins Best Original Song award (March 13, 2023)

The song 'Naatu Naatu' from the Indian film RRR has won the Oscar in the Best Original Song category at the 95th Oscar Awards.

An overview of the news

- RRR is the first Indian film to be nominated for Academy Awards in the last two decades, while 'Naatu Naatu' was the first Indian song to be nominated for an Oscar.
- The song beat out other nominees in the category including Applause (Tell It Like a Woman), Hold My Hand (Top Gun Maverick), Lift Me Up (Black Pather Wakanda Forever) and This Is a Life (Everything Everywhere All At).
- Music director **MM Keeravani** received the award.
- This Telugu song is sung by **Kaal Bhairav & Rahul Sipligunj**. 'Naatu-naatu' means '**to dance'.**
- The song is picturized on actors **Ram Charan and Jr NTR**, in which their peppy dance moves have also been appreciated.
- It is noteworthy that the song 'Jai Ho' from the UK film 'Slumdog Millionaire' directed by **Danny Boyle** is the **first Hindi song** to win an Academy Award in the Best Original Score and Original Song categories.
- Its music was composed by **AR Rahman** and its lyrics were written by **Gulzar.**
- Rajamouli's RRR received several American awards, made it to the BAFTA 2023 in the Film Not in the English Language category, won the Golden Globe in the Best Original Song category, and also won the Best Song award at the 28th edition of the Critics' Choice Awards.
