1. ICG ship 'Kamla Devi', last vessel of FPV series, commissioned (Jan. 13, 2023)

Fast Patrol Vessel (FPV) ICG ship '**Kamala Devi**' was commissioned on 12 January in **Kolkata**, the capital of West Bengal.

An overview of the news

- This Fast Patrol Vessel (FPV) designed, built and delivered by Garden Reach Shipbuilders and Engineers (GRSE) Ltd to the Indian Coast Guard.
- A passenger-cum-cargo ocean going ferry 'MV Ma Lisha' built by the shipyard for the Republic of Guyana was also flagged off.
- This is the first such ship built by a Defense Public Sector Shipyard for export to a Latin American country.

About ICG Kamla Devi

- ICG Kamla Devi is **48.9 meters long and 7.5 meters wide** with a **displacement of 308 tonnes**.
- It is capable of a top speed of **34 knots** and an endurance of over **1,500 nautical miles**, with three engines and water jets.
- She also has an integrated bridge system and is fitted with a **40/60 gun** as the main armament.
- The ship has advanced livable facilities with fully air-conditioned accommodation for 35 personnel.
- ICGS Kamla Devi will patrol the seas and undertake **anti-smuggling**, **anti-poaching** and search and rescue operations when required.

About MV Ma Lisha

- It has been designed and built by **GRSE** and will be housed at **Chennai**, a semisubmersible vessel **MV Sun Rise** for the long voyage to **Guyana**.
- The ship was launched on **June 15**, **2022** and within six months, GRSE secured the 'technical acceptance' of the ship on December 16.
- The **70 metre long** vessel with a displacement of **1,700 tonnes** is propelled by two diesel engines and can attain a maximum speed of **15 knots**.
- The ship can accommodate **294 passengers** including **14 crew members** along with **14 cars**, two trucks and 14 containers and cargo.

2. Centre approved ₹2,600 crore as incentive for banks to promote digital payments (Jan. 12, 2023)

Centre approved ₹2,600 crore as incentive for banks to promote digital payments

The Union Cabinet on 11 January approved a ₹2,600 crore scheme for promoting RuPay debit cards and low-value BHIM-UPI transactions.

An overview of the news

- Under the scheme, banks will be given financial incentives in the current financial year 2022-23 to promote 'Point of Sale' (PoS) i.e. payment machines and e-commerce transactions using RuPay and UPI.
- The Cabinet has approved this incentive scheme to promote small amount transactions between individuals and merchants through RuPay Debit Cards and BHIM-UPI.
- This will further strengthen **India's progress in digital payments**. Finance Minister **Nirmala Sitharaman** had said in the last budget, will continue to provide financial help to increase digital payments.
- India has remained a cash-dependent economy since independence. **India's Cash to GDP ratio is 13%** while the global average is at most **8%**.

Significance of the Incentive Scheme

- The government had approved an incentive scheme in pursuance of the budget announcement for FY 2022 to promote digital transactions.
- As a result, total digital payment transactions registered a year-on-year growth of 59 percent.
- This increased from ₹5,554 crore in FY21 to ₹8,840 crore in FY22.
- BHIM-UPI transactions registered a year-on-year growth of 106 per cent, from Rs 2,233 crore in FY21 to Rs 4,597 crore in FY22.
- This incentive scheme will promote as a digital payment solution and enable further deepening of digital payments in the country.

3. Grand cultural program 'Sur Sarita-Symphony of Ganga' organised in Varanasi (Jan. 12, 2023)

On the eve of the launch of the world's longest river cruise 'MV Ganga Vilas Cruise' on January 12, a grand cultural program 'Sur Sarita-Symphony of Ganga' was organised in Varanasi.

An overview of the news

- Renowned singer **Shankar Mahadevan** led the grand concert being organised at the **Kashi Vishwanath Corridor.**
- The nearly one-hour show ended with Shankar Mahadevan's rendition of 'Kartavya Ganga'.
- During the concert, tourists and other dignitaries travelling on Ganga Vilas Cruise enjoyed the **Sur Taranginis**.
- A grand cultural program 'Sur Sarita Symphony of Ganga' was organized by the **Ministry of Culture.**
- The world's longest river cruise MV Ganga Vilas will be flagged off by Prime Minister Narendra Modi on January 13, in Varanasi.
- This luxury cruise over the coming 51 days will not only bring **India's cruise tourism potential** to the world but also showcase India's natural beauty, cultural heritage and spiritual splendour.
- Ganga Vilas Cruise will cross **Uttar Pradesh, Bihar, Bangladesh and Assam** in a journey of 51 days.

4. Indian High Commission signs MoU to establish Hindi Chair at Sabaragamuwa University of Sri Lanka (Jan. 12, 2023)

After World Hindi Day, the Indian High Commission signed an MoU to establish a Hindi Chair at Sabaragamuwa University in Sri Lanka.

An overview of the news

- High Commissioner **Gopal Bagale** and Vice-Chancellor of Sabaragamuwa University **Prof. Uday Ratnayake** signed an MoU for establishment of Hindi Chair for cultural engagement through **Indian Council for Cultural Relations.**
- The Hindi Chair will help to acquaint the students with India, its **history and culture.**
- This will pave the way for popularising Hindi by appointing Indian faculties.
- The Indian High Commissioner emphasised on sustainable use of resources by adopting innovative strategies in the event.
- The Indian Mission will award a **gold medal** to the best-performing student of the Hindi Chair.

Sabaragamuwa University of Sri Lanka

• It is a public university in **Belihuloya**, **Balangoda**, **Sri Lanka**.

It was established on 20 November 1991 and consists of nine faculties.

5. US to support restoration of Hyderabad's Paigah tombs (Jan. 12, 2023)

Financial assistance of **\$250,000** (through the US Ambassador's Fund for Cultural Preservation) will be provided by the **US** for the conservation and restoration of **6 Paigah tombs** built in the **18th-19th centuries in Hyderabad.**

An overview of the news

- The project will be implemented by the **Aga Khan Trust for Culture.**
- Paigah Tombs Complex is a protected complex of the Department of Archaeology, Government of Telangana.
- The Paigah Tomb (or Tomb Shams al-Umra) is a mausoleum belonging to the nobility of the **Paigah family**, who served the **Nizam of Hyderabad** (Asaf Jahi dynasty).
- The construction of this mausoleum was started by Nawab Tegjung Bahadur in 1787 and later his son Amir-e-Kabir I helped in its construction.
- It is also known for its architectural design. It is believed that the architectural style of the **mausoleum** is unique in the whole world.
- The mausoleum is decorated with lime marble and shows a mixture of **Greek, Persian, Mughal, Rajasthani, Asif Jahi and Deccani architecture.**
- The Paigahs were among the most **influential and powerful families** of Hyderabad in the 18th century. They were wealthier than most rulers, as well as responsible for the security and defence of the region.
- The Paigahs claim to be descended from **Hazrat Umar bin al-Khattab**, the second Caliph of Islam.

6. Centre named new Integrated Food Security Scheme as Pradhan Mantri Garib Kalyan Ann Yojana (Jan. 12, 2023)

The new integrated food security scheme has been named as PM Garib Kalyan Anna Yojana ((PMGKAY) to provide free food grains to Antyodaya Anna Yojana (AAY) and Primary Household (PHH) beneficiaries.

An overview of the news

 Keeping in view the welfare of the beneficiaries and to maintain uniformity across states, all PHH and AAY beneficiaries will be provided free food grains under PMGKAY for 2023.

- This integrated scheme will strengthen the provisions of **NFSA**, **2013** in terms of access, affordability and availability of food grains to the poor.
- The implementation of this new scheme has started from **January 1, 2023**, which is benefiting more than **80 crore poor people.**
- The central government will spend over **Rs 2 lakh crore** in 2023 as food subsidy under NFSA and other welfare schemes to ease the financial burden of the poor.

PM Garib Kalyan Anna Yojana ((PMGKAY)

- It is a part of Pradhan Mantri Garib Kalyan Package (PMGKP) to help the poor fight the battle against **Covid-19.**
- Its nodal Ministry is the **Ministry of Finance.**
- Under this scheme, the government provides additional free of cost 5 kg per person per month food-grains (rice/wheat) to around 80 crore beneficiaries of National Food Security Act (NFSA) including the Direct Benefit Transfer (DBT) beneficiaries.
- The PMGKAY has now been linked with **One Nation One Ration Card (ONORC)** plan where migrant workers can get the benefit of the scheme through any ration shops in India.

7. 13th India-US Trade Policy Forum (Jan. 12, 2023)

Piyush Goyal was on an official visit to **New York and Washington DC** from January 9-11 to participate in the **India-US Trade Policy Forum**.

An overview of the news

- The 13th Trade Policy Forum (TPF) meeting was hosted by US Trade Representative Catherine Tai in Washington on 11 January.
- Commerce and Industry Minister Piyush Goyal at the forum urged the US to expedite the **issuance of business visas** so that people can make short trips to pursue their trade and business interests.
- After participating in the forum, he said that the issuance of business visas in India is taking a long time and needs to be expedited so that investments are not affected.
- His visit included delegation-level talks and a meeting with **US Trade Representative**Ambassador Catherine Tai.
- There is an increasing movement of professionals, students, skilled workers, investors and business travellers between the two countries.
- According to the commerce ministry, in 2021-22, the bilateral trade between the US and India stood at USD 119.42 billion as against USD 80.51 billion in 2020-21.

About the India-US Trade Policy Forum

- It is a platform for continued engagement between the two countries in the field of **trade** and to further enhance bilateral trade and **investment ties.**
- The **12th TPF** Ministerial Conference was held in **New Delhi** on 23 November 2021 after a gap of four years.

8. Punjabi will be taught in Australian schools (Jan. 11, 2023)

Punjabi is all set to be the newest language to be taught in public schools of **Western Australia**. The Australian government has decided to include **Punjabi language in schools**.

An overview of the news

- The number of Punjabi speakers in Australia is continuously increasing. Punjabi language has become the **fastest growing language** in this country.
- According to the 2021 census, **Punjabi** is the fastest growing language in Australia, with more than **239,000 people** using the language at home.
- In comparison to the year 2016, there has been an **increase of 80 percent** in the number of Punjabi speakers in Australia in the year 2021.
- This year the syllabus from **pre-primary to 12th** will be prepared. After including Tamil, Hindi and Korean languages in the curriculum in 2021, it has been decided to teach Punjabi in schools.
- With over **190 languages** spoken in Australia, linguistic diversity is a great strength that provides social, cultural and economic benefits.

- Now the new light and sound show will further strengthen the **patriotic pride** among the audience.

10. India, Panama sign agreement on cooperation in training diplomats (Jan. 10, 2023)

- The visit of the Panamanian Foreign Minister to India comes more than a month after the two sides held the **2nd Foreign Office Consultations (FOC) in Panama City** on November 23, 2022.

- During the consultations, both sides comprehensively reviewed their bilateral relations
- covering issues such as trade and investment, pharmaceuticals, capacity building, space cooperation and consular.
- Both countries also discussed cooperation in **multilateral fora.**
- Both countries agreed to hold the next round of consultations at a mutually convenient date in **New Delhi**.
