1. Former Zimbabwe cricket captain Heath Streak passes away at the age of 49 (Sept. 4, 2023)

Former Zimbabwe cricket captain Heath Streak passed away at the age of 49 due to colon and liver cancer on 3rd September 2023.

An Overview of the News

- Heath Streak is known for his skills as a fast bowler.
- Zimbabwe's all-time leading wicket-taker in Test cricket with 216 wickets at an average of 28.14.
- Scored 1,990 runs in Test matches at an average of 22.35.
- In ODIs, Streak took 239 wickets at 29.82 and scored 2,943 runs at 28.29.
- Represented Zimbabwe in 65 Tests and 189 ODIs from 1993 to 2005.
- Streak established the **Heath Streak Academy in 2014 to support cricket development in Zimbabwe.**

- AIR is the **world's largest radio network** and one of the largest broadcasting organizations globally, serving a wide variety of languages and cultures.
- It operates **420 stations across India**, covering approximately 92% of the country's area and reaching 99.19% of the total population.
- AIR produces programming in 23 languages and 179 dialects.

3. Uday Kotak resigns as CEO of Kotak Mahindra Bank (Sept. 4, 2023)

Uday Kotak resigned as Managing Director and CEO of Kotak Mahindra Bank with effect from September 1, 2023.

- During his tenure in the Film Division, he was instrumental in establishing the **National Museum of Indian Cinema in Mumbai**.
- Desai also worked at PIB Mumbai for over ten years, where he managed media-related activities for several national and international events including the International Film Festival of India (IFFI) held in Goa.

Press Information Bureau (PIB):

• It was established in **June 1919 at Shimla** as a small unit under the Ministry of Home Affairs of the British Government.

Its initial objective was to compile a report on India for presentation to the

- British Parliament.
- Dr. LF Rushbrook Williams of Allahabad University was the first head of the Publicity Cell and served as Officer on Special Duty.
- In 1941, J Natarajan became the first Indian to lead the Bureau as Principal Information Officer.
- In **1946** the name of the organization was officially changed to the **Press Information Bureau.**

7. Piyush Goyal unveils statue of RK Shanmugam Chetty in Coimbatore (Sept. 1, 2023)

Union Minister Piyush Goyal unveiled the statue of RK Shanmugam Chetty, the first Finance Minister of independent India, in Coimbatore.

- The unveiling took place at the South Indian Mills Association Complex (SIMA) in Coimbatore.
- The event was attended by Union Minister of State for Railways and Textiles Darshana V. Jhardosh, Coimbatore South MLA Vanathi Srinivasan, and senior officials of the South Indian Mills Association.
