'Blockbill' app

- BlockBill is a blockchain-based **receipt generation app** that generates digital receipts for all its users' transactions.
- This app solves many problems, transitioning from producing thermal paper to printing receipts.
- Thermal papers that are ubiquitous and found in most retail locations cannot be recycled due to the chemicals used to make them.
- Blockbills have been conceptualised to address this issue.
