10. Jyotiraditya Scindia inaugurates 4th Heli-India Summit 2022 (Oct. 10, 2022)

Union Civil Aviation Minister **Jyotiraditya Scindia** and Jammu and Kashmir Lieutenant Governor **Manoj Sinha** inaugurated the **4th Heli-India Summit 2022** in **Srinagar** on 10 October.

Important facts

- The theme of 4th Heli-India Summit 2022 is '**Helicopters for last Mile Connectivity**'.
- He said that a civil enclave will be built in Jammu at a cost of Rs 861 crores and the Srinagar's present terminal will be expanded three times from 20,000 square meters to 60,000 square meters at a cost of Rs 1500 crores.
- He said that the decrease in VAT on **Aviation Turbine Fuel (ATF)** from 26.5 percent to one percent by the J&K government.
- The **HeliSewa portal** is completely online and is being used by all operators to obtain landing permissions for helipads, and is also creating a database of helipads in the country.
- **Helidisha**, guidance material on helicopter operations for the state administration has been distributed in 780 districts.

- Helicopter Accelerator cell is fully proactive in resolving helicopter issues and an advisory group of industry representatives is helping to identify the problem areas.
- Three helicopter corridors have been built from Mumbai-Pune, Ahmedabad-Gandhinagar and Shamshabad-Begumpet and new IFR corridors are being planned.
 - In terms of railway connectivity, Jammu and Kashmir will be connected with Kanyakumari by next year.
