8. Greece's centre-right leader Kyriakos Mitsotakis sworn in as Prime Minister (June 27, 2023)

Kyriakos Mitsotakis, the leader of Greece's centre-right New Democracy party, was sworn in as Prime Minister for a second term on 26th June.

An overview of the news

- The swearing-in ceremony took place at the presidential palace in the presence of the **leader of the Greek Orthodox Church**, following the country's tradition.
- Mitsotakis expressed his gratitude for the strong mandate given to him by the voters and pledged to accelerate institutional and economic reforms.
- He emphasized that major reforms would be implemented rapidly, and he had ambitious targets for his next four years in power that could bring transformative changes to Greece.
- With 99.67 percent of the vote counted, New Democracy secured 40.55 percent of the vote, more than twice the percentage obtained by the main opposition party, Syriza.
- Under the new electoral law that prioritizes the first party, New Democracy secured a comfortable majority of 158 seats in the 300-member Parliament, while Syriza obtained 48 seats.
- Kyriakos Mitsotakis, aged 55 and a **Harvard graduate**, comes from a prominent political family in Greece, with his father serving as Prime Minister in the 1990s and his sister and nephew also holding political positions.

Portugal's star footballer Cristiano Ronaldo has made another big record. Ronaldo has become the first football player in history to play 200 international matches.

An overview of the news

- The 38-year-old Ronaldo set this record as soon as he was named in the playing XI against Iceland in the **2024 Euro Cup qualifying match.**
- The **Guinness World Records team** honored Ronaldo for this record before the match.
- In the match held in **Iceland's capital Reykjavik, Ronaldo scored a goal in the 89th minute** and gave the team a 1-0 victory over Iceland.
- With this win, Portugal have retained the top spot in Group J with wins from all four matches they have played so far.

Cristiano Ronaldo

- Cristiano Ronaldo made his international debut for Portugal on 20 August 2003.
- Now even after almost 20 years, this player is not only playing matches but is also playing an important role in helping his team win.

Ronaldo also holds the record for **most international goals with 123 goals.**

Player with most international matches

- **Kuwait's Bader Al-Mutawa** is in **second place** in terms of playing most international matches, who has played a total of 196 matches so far.
- Malaysia's Soh Chin Ain is third with 195 matches.
- Lionel Messi of Argentina is joint 11th with 175 matches.
- Team India captain **Sunil Chhetri tops the list playing 137 international** matches for India.
