1. SVAMITVA Yojana of Ministry of Panchayati Raj gets National Award for e-Governance 2023 (Aug. 28, 2023)

In the 26th National Conference on e-Governance 2023, the National Award was given to the SVAMITVA (Survey of Villages Abadi and Mapping with Improvised Technology in Village Areas) scheme of the Ministry of Panchayati Raj.

An Overview of the News

- The objective of the SVAMITVA scheme is to survey the population of villages, map rural areas with advanced technology, and provide ownership rights of property to individuals living in rural areas.
- State-of-the-art technologies such as drones and Geographic Information Systems (GIS) are used for this initiative.
- Property cards have been created, which enable rural property owners to leverage their property for financial benefits.

Significance of the Award:

- The event is in line with the government's vision to strengthen the legal aid ecosystem and ensure equitable access to justice for all.

3. B20 Summit India 2023 begins in New Delhi (Aug. 25, 2023)

B20 Summit India 2023 began in New Delhi on 25 August.

An Overview of the News

- During the three days, the summit will be attended by various prominent personalities, including Union Ministers like Nirmala Sitharaman, Dharmendra Pradhan, and Dr. S Jaishankar.
- The first day of the summit will host seven sessions covering topics like B20 India's priorities, global alignment, Artificial Intelligence's role in business and society, trade opportunities and regulations, resilient global trade's inclusive value chains, and a session with Trade Ministers.
- Eminent leaders including Tata Sons Executive Chairman and B20 India Chairman N Chandrasekaran, Mastercard CEO Michael Meibach, and World Economic Forum President Borge Brende will be present.
- The theme of the summit is "B20 India R.I.S.E." which is a symbol of responsible, agile, innovative, sustainable, and equitable businesses.
- Under the chairmanship of India, seven task forces were set up, covering areas such as global value chains, future of work, skill development, mobility, digital transformation, financing economic reforms, climate change, technology, innovation, and financial inclusion for empowerment.
- Summit discussions expanded to two Action Councils focusing on environmental, social, and governance (ESG) matters related to business and African economic integration.

4. World Water Week - 20 to 24 August (Aug. 23, 2023)

History of World Water Week

- World Water Week is a recurring global event that has taken place every year since its inception in 1991.
- The event is organized by the Stockholm International Water Institute (SIWI), a non-profit organization committed to advocating for sustainable water solutions.

- The first World Water Week was held in 1991 in Stockholm, Sweden.
- The theme of the opening ceremony was "Water: An Imminent Crisis."
- The event brought together water experts and professionals from around the world to discuss and address challenges related to water scarcity and pollution.
- Since its inception, World Water Week has been held continuously in Stockholm.

- The Senate Chairman has accepted Kakar's resignation as per Article 64, Clause (1) of the Constitution of Pakistan.

- Adoption of the TCRM Matrix framework requires a comprehensive analysis and contextualization within specific national and regional innovation scenarios.
- The launch of the Techno-Commercial Readiness and Market Maturity Matrix (TCRM Matrix) framework is a milestone for India's innovation and entrepreneurship landscape.

National Institution for Transforming India (NITI) Aayog:

• On January 1, 2015, a new institution NITI Aayog was formed in place of the Planning Commission, envisaging maximum governance, minimum government, emphasizing the spirit of 'cooperative federalism'.

Composition of NITI Aayog:

- Chairman: Prime Minister
- Vice President: Appointed by the Prime Minister
- **Governing Council:** Chief Ministers of all States and Lieutenant Governors of Union Territories.
- **Regional Council:** The Prime Minister or his nominee presides over meetings of Chief Ministers and Lieutenant Governors to address specific regional issues.
- **Ex-officio Membership:** Up to four members of the Union Council of Ministers nominated by the Prime Minister.
- Ad-hoc Membership: Two ex-officio members by rotation from leading research institutions.
- **Chief Executive Officer:** Secretary to the Government of India who is appointed by the Prime Minister for a fixed term.
- **Special Invitees:** Experts in various fields nominated by the Prime Minister.

9. World's largest International Temple Convention and Expo organized in Varanasi (July 13, 2023)

World's-largest-International-Temple-Convention-and-Expo-organized-in-Varanasi The world's largest **International Temple Convention and Expo (ITCX)** will be organized from 22 to 24 July 2023 at the **Rudraksh Convention Center in Varanasi**.

An Overview of the news:

- Conceived by **Temple Connect (India)**, it is the world's first event solely dedicated to the management of temples.
- The conference will focus on nurturing and empowering the governance, management and operations of the world and temple ecosystem.

Conference Participation:

- More than 450 temple functionaries from 25 countries are expected to participate in the conference.
- Along with Hindus, office bearers of Math-Temples and Gurudwaras belonging to **Sikh**, **Buddhist and Jainism** have also been invited.

Launch of the conference:

- The conference will be inaugurated by RSS chief **Mohan Bhagwat** on July 22.
- The event will be held at Rudraksh Convention Centre.
- For the first time, the International Temples Convention & Expo is being organized by Temple Connect.

Conference organized under Incredible India:

- The three-day event is being organized as part of the Incredible India campaign in collaboration with the Union Ministry of Tourism.
- In this, development, empowerment of temple management, operation and administration will be discussed.
- According to the founder of Temple Connect, best practices will be created for the teams of the leading places of worship in the world.

Theme of the conference:

- During this conference, the experience of pilgrims visiting temples, monasteries and gurudwaras will be asked, topics like crowd management, solid waste management and what should be improved in basic facilities will also be discussed.
- The conference will serve as a platform to introduce the world to India's rich heritage of places of worship, while learning about the diverse cultures, traditions, arts and crafts of places of worship around the world.

10. Union Ministry of Education releases Performance Grading Index for States (July 10, 2023)

Performance-Grading-Index-for-States

The Department of School Education and Literacy, Ministry of Education released the **Performance Grading Index (PGI)** report for States/UTs, an index for evidence based comprehensive analysis of school education system in State/UTs.

An Overview of the news:

• According to PGI, even though the states have been successful to a great extent in recent years in connecting most of the children to schools, they are still far behind in the standards of teaching-learning and quality.

PGI 2.0:

• This year's report released by the Ministry of Education has been named PGI 2.0.

Punjab and Chandigarh on top in overall ranking:

- No state has been found in the top-5 category of PGI. Punjab and Chandigarh have been placed at the top position with the highest number of points in the overall ranking of PGI.
- While on the parameters of learning outcome and quality, **Rajasthan** has also topped with **Punjab and Chandigarh** with the highest marks.

Six Standards and Ten Categories:

- The Ministry has set **six standards and ten categories** in place of the earlier **five standards and eight categories** to determine the performance of the states in school education, in which the subject of teacher education has been added anew.
- In these indexes, the weightage (marks) given on the basis of government work has been reduced.

Six Standards of PGI 2.0:

- Among the six parameters on the basis of which this grade of states has been prepared,
- Learning Outcome and Quality,
- Access to School
- Infrastructure and Facilities,
- Equality,
- Governance Management and
- Includes teacher education and training.
- States have been given marks on the basis of 73 different parameters of all these.

Ten categories of PGI:

- The ten categories that have been created under PGI, which is based on 1000 marks, include:
- Daksha (941-1000)
- Utkarsh (881-940)
- Ati Uttam(821-880)
- Uttam (761-820)
- Pracheshta-1(701-760)
- Prachesta-2 (641-700)
- Pracheshta-3 (581-640)
- Aspirant-1 (521-580)
- Aspirant- 2 (461-520) and
- Akankshi-3 (401-460).

No state in top five:

- In the PGI-2.0 report for the year 2021-22, there is no state in the top-5 categories in the overall ranking, while **Punjab and Chandigarh** have found place in the sixth category i.e. **Prachesta-2.**
- Gujarat, Kerala, Maharashtra, Delhi, Puducherry, Tamil Nadu were in the seventh category i.e. **Prachesta-3.**
- Thirteen states have made it to the eighth category of overall ranking i.e. **Aspirational-1**, including Andhra Pradesh, Chhattisgarh, Goa, Haryana, Madhya Pradesh, Himachal Pradesh, Rajasthan, Karnataka, Sikkim, West Bengal, Andaman and Nicobar, Lakshadweep, Daman and Dadar Nagar Haveli is included.

• 12 states including Uttar Pradesh, Bihar, Uttarakhand, Jharkhand have made it to the ninth category i.e. **Akankshi-2**.
