- She also participated as a panelist in the ADB Governors' Seminar on Policies to Support Asia's Rebound.

The functions of the Union Finance Minister included the following components:

- Interaction with global economists, governors/finance ministers of ADB member countries, etc.
- Bilateral engagement with countries and international organizations.
- Interact with global business leaders and investors in roundtables.
- Engagement with community diaspora.

Asian Development Bank (ADB)

- It is a **regional multilateral financial institution** which focuses on the countries of **Asia and Pacific region.**
- It was set up after a resolution was passed at the first Ministerial Conference on Asian Economic Cooperation held by the United Nations Economic Commission for Asia and the Far East in 1963.
- It started functioning from 19 December 1966 with 31 member countries.
- At present it has **68 members—of which 49 members are from within Asia** and the Pacific and 19 outside.
- Japan is the largest shareholder of the ADB and a Japanese has always been the head of the ADB.

4. 'Machines can See' - Summit on Artificial Intelligence held at Dubai (May 4, 2023)

The UAE government launched the 'Machines Can See 2023' summit in Dubai, one of the first international conferences in Artificial Intelligence (AI) across the region.

An overview of the news

- The conference is being held in partnership between **Artificial Intelligence**, **Digital Economy**, and **Remote Work Applications Office and 'Machines Can See' company**.
- The conference aims to bring together experts from around the world to discuss the future of Al and its potential to contribute to the UAE's vision of creating the next Silicon Valley.
- The event was organized in collaboration with the **Dubai Department of Economic** and **Tourism and the Dubai Future Foundation**.
- The summit included presentations and panel discussions from various experts in the field of AI.
- The **UAE** is the only country with a state-level Al programme, which is a testament to its commitment to supporting the progress of Al technology.

5. India to build Harbour for Maldivian Coast Guard (May 4, 2023)

India to build Harbour for Maldivian Coast Guard

India and Maldives launched construction of 'Ekatha Harbour' for the Coast Guard of the Maldives National Defence Force (MNDF).

An overview of the news

- The foundation stone for the Coast Guard 'Ekatha Harbour' was laid by Defence Minister Rajnath Singh and his Maldivian counterpart, Mariya Didi, at Sifavaru in Uthuru Thila Falhu (UTF) atoll, where India is assisting in construction of a naval dockyard.
- This is the biggest grant-in-aid project of India in Maldives.

UTF project

- The UTF project, announced during External Affairs Minister **S Jaishankar's visit in February 2021**, has been at the centre of a political controversy in the Maldives.
- Allegations that the project was meant for Indian military presence in the Indian Ocean nation were part of an "India Out" campaign, which was supported by the country's opposition leader, **Abdulla Yameen**.

- Last April, Maldivian President Ibrahim Solih **banned anti-India protests** as a threat to national security.
- Anti-India campaigners allege that Indian troops were stationed in a fast patrol vessel India recently gifted to Maldives Coast Guard.

Recent gifts of India to Maldives

- India gifted a **Dornier aircraft** to Maldives in 2020 and a patrol ship in 2019.
- In 2022, India had also given Coastal Radar System to Male.
- Last year, Modi had announced that India would provide **24 vehicles** and a naval boat and build police facilities on the country's **61 islands.**

6. Paraguay's Colorado Party's Santiago Peña wins presidential election (May 3, 2023)

Paraguay's Colorado Party's Santiago Peña wins presidential election

Santiago Peña, an economist from Paraguay's ruling conservative Colorado party, won the country's presidential election.

An Overview of the News

- The election was decided in a single round of voting, and with nearly all ballots counted,
 Santiago Peña received over 42% of the vote.
- His main challenger, Efrain Alegre, who represented the Concertación Nacional coalition, received about 28% of the vote.
- The Colorado Party has been the dominant political force in Paraguay for more than 70 years, and Santiago Peña's victory solidified its hold on power.
- Despite an expected economic growth of more than 4% this year, Paraguay still struggles with high levels of poverty and corruption.

About Paraguay

- It is a country **located in the middle of South America.** It is a landlocked country, bordered by **Argentina**, **Brazil and Bolivia**.

The first ASEAN-India Maritime Exercise (AIME-2023) began on 2 May in Singapore.

An overview of the news

- The maiden exercise is being conducted **off the coast of Singapore.**
- It aims to enhance interoperability and exchange of best practices among the participating navies.
- **INS Satpura and INS Delhi,** accompanied by RADM Gurcharan Singh, Flag Officer Commanding Eastern Fleet, have reached Singapore to participate in the exercise.
- AIME 2023 will provide an opportunity for **Indian Navy and ASEAN navies** to work together closely and conduct seamless operations in the maritime domain.
- Indian Navy ships will also participate in the International Maritime Security Conference (IMSC) and the International Maritime Defense Exhibition (IMDEX-23).
- The Philippine Navy has deployed its **missile frigate BRP Antonio Luna (FF-151)** with a 140-man crew of Naval Task Group 80.5 onboard in the exercise.

Phase of the exercise

- Harbour Phase to be conducted at Changi Naval Base.
- Sea Phase to be conducted in the South China Sea.

INS Delhi and INS Satpura

- INS Delhi is India's first indigenously-built guided missile destroyer.
- INS Satpura, is an indigenously built guided missile stealth frigate and are fitted with state-of-the art weapons and sensors.
- Both are part of the **Eastern Fleet based at Visakhapatnam** and are under the operational command of the Flag Officer Commanding-in-Chief, Eastern Naval Command.

8. India to hand-over fast Patrol Vessel ship & landing Craft to Maldives (May 2, 2023)

Defence Minister Rajnath Singh will hand over a fast patrol vessel and a landing craft to the Maldives as India's "gift" during his visit to the island nation from May 1 to 3.

An overview of the news

• It will be an "**important landmark**" in building "**strong bonds"** of friendship between the two countries.

- Maldives is one of India's major maritime neighbors in the Indian Ocean region and
