1. Law Minister launches Tele-Law 2.0 (Sept. 2, 2023)

Union Minister Arjun Ram Meghwal launches Tele-Law 2.0 for legal advice.

An Overview of the News

- Screening of the "Tele-Law" documentary, chronicling the journey of Tele-Law from 2017 to 2022.
- Launch of "Tele-Law-2.0", which integrates Tele-Law and Nyay Bandhu apps, along with the release of an informative e-tutorial.
- Unveiling the fourth edition of the **Voice of Beneficiaries booklet,** featuring real-life stories of individuals whose lives were positively impacted by Tele-Law.

- The **Disha scheme, launched in 2021**, has a duration of five years (2021-2026) and aims **to promote and increase access to justice for all in India.**

Tele-Law 2.0:

- The Department of Justice (DoJ) is conducting a program called Tele-Law 2.0 as part of its commitment to **Article 39A**, which **aims to provide "justice for all".**
- The primary goal of the Tele-Law program is to positively impact the lives of one crore (ten million) beneficiaries by achieving this milestone well before the year 2026.

Tele-Law Programs:

- In 2017, the Tele-Law program was launched.
- The Department of Justice (DOJ) collaborated with the National Legal Services Authority (NALSA) and CSC e-Governance Service India Limited to facilitate the delivery of legal aid to the underprivileged population.
- The primary objective of this partnership was to ensure that marginalized communities have access to legal aid by leveraging Common Service Centers (CSCs).

Nyay Bandhu App:

• This app is part of Tele-Law 2.0, which combines Tele-Law services and the Nyaya Bandhu Android application.

Its primary goal is to provide free legal guidance and representation to citizens.

- Nyay Bandhu (Pro Bono Legal Services) was **started in 2017.**
- The objective of this initiative is to establish a nationwide framework to provide free legal aid.
- "Pro bono legal services" means providing legal assistance voluntarily and without charge.
- The Latin phrase "pro bono" translates to "for free" in English.

2. India to host the first edition of the 'Global IndiaAl 2023' conference in October (Aug. 31, 2023)

The inaugural edition of 'Global IndiaAl 2023' will be hosted by India in October.

An Overview of the News

- The responsibility for organizing this program will be of the Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology.
- The conference will attract leading figures in the field of AI, such as key players, researchers, startups, and investors from India and around the world.
- A variety of topics will be covered during the program, ranging from next-generation learning and foundational AI models to applications of AI in healthcare, governance and the advancement of electric vehicles.
- The conference will also discuss future trends in AI research, AI computing systems, investment prospects and strategies to promote AI talent.
- The proceedings of the conference are being monitored by Rajiv Chandrashekhar, Union Minister of State for Skill Development and Entrepreneurship and Electronics and IT.

3. SVAMITVA Yojana of Ministry of Panchayati Raj gets National Award for e-Governance 2023 (Aug. 28, 2023)

In the 26th National Conference on e-Governance 2023, the National Award was given to the SVAMITVA (Survey of Villages Abadi and Mapping with Improvised Technology in Village Areas) scheme of the Ministry of Panchayati Raj.

An Overview of the News

- The objective of the SVAMITVA scheme is to survey the population of villages, map rural areas with advanced technology, and provide ownership rights of property to individuals living in rural areas.
- State-of-the-art technologies such as drones and Geographic Information Systems (GIS) are used for this initiative.

Property cards have been created, which enable rural property owners to leverage their property for financial benefits.

Significance of the Award:

5. B20 Summit India 2023 begins in New Delhi (Aug. 25, 2023)

B20 Summit India 2023 began in New Delhi on 25 August.

- During the three days, the summit will be attended by various prominent personalities, including Union Ministers like Nirmala Sitharaman, Dharmendra Pradhan, and Dr. S Jaishankar.
- The first day of the summit will host seven sessions covering topics like B20 India's priorities, global alignment, Artificial Intelligence's role in business and society, trade opportunities and regulations, resilient global trade's inclusive value chains, and a session with Trade Ministers.

- The theme of the summit is "B20 India R.I.S.E." which is a symbol of responsible, agile, innovative, sustainable, and equitable businesses.
- Under the chairmanship of India, seven task forces were set up, covering areas such as global value chains, future of work, skill development, mobility, digital transformation,

financing economic reforms, climate change, technology, innovation, and financial inclusion for empowerment.

• Summit discussions expanded to two Action Councils focusing on environmental, social, and governance (ESG) matters related to business and African economic integration.

6. World Water Week - 20 to 24 August (Aug. 23, 2023)

National Institution for Transforming India (NITI) Aayog:

• On January 1, 2015, a new institution NITI Aayog was formed in place of the Planning Commission, envisaging maximum governance, minimum government, emphasizing the spirit of 'cooperative federalism'.

Composition of NITI Aayog:

- Chairman: Prime Minister
- Vice President: Appointed by the Prime Minister
- **Governing Council:** Chief Ministers of all States and Lieutenant Governors of Union Territories.
- **Regional Council:** The Prime Minister or his nominee presides over meetings of Chief Ministers and Lieutenant Governors to address specific regional issues.
- **Ex-officio Membership:** Up to four members of the Union Council of Ministers nominated by the Prime Minister.
- Ad-hoc Membership: Two ex-officio members by rotation from leading research institutions.
- Chief Executive Officer: Secretary to the Government of India who is appointed by the Prime Minister for a fixed term.
- Special Invitees: Experts in various fields nominated by the Prime Minister.
