- Its mandate includes addressing human rights violations, making recommendations to improve human rights standards, and investigating and reporting human rights abuses.
- The **UNHRC is composed of 47 member states** elected for three-year terms, and holds three regular sessions each year.
- It conducts a **Universal Periodic Review (UPR) process** to review the human rights records of all member states of the United Nations.
- The UNHRC has thematic mandates to address specific human rights issues and country mandates to investigate human rights abuses in a particular country.
- The UNHRC cooperates with other United Nations bodies to promote and protect human rights, such as the Office of the **High Commissioner for Human Rights (OHCHR) and the International Criminal Court (ICC).**
