- Kaziranga Gaja Utsav is an **annual festival** held in the national park to promote the **conservation and protection of elephants.**
- It is jointly organized by the **Forest and Tourism Departments** to draw attention and find a solution to the growing human-elephant conflict in the state.
- This is being organized to mark the completion of **30 years of Project Elephant.**

- The Government of India started **Project Elephant in the year 1992** to protect
- elephants, their migration routes and natural habitats.
- Assam has the second largest population of elephants in the country after Karnataka.
- Kaziranga National Park being a UNESCO World Heritage Site is an ideal place for Gaja Utsav.

#### **About the G20**

• It is an international forum for economic cooperation that plays an important role in shaping global governance on major economic issues.

India will chair the G20 from December 2022 to November 2023.

- The G20 was **established in 1999** after the **Asian financial crisis** as a forum for finance ministers and central bank governors.
- In 2008, the G20 was upgraded to the level of heads of state/government in response to the global financial crisis.
- The G20 focuses on a wide range of topics, including **trade**, **sustainable development**, **health**, **agriculture**, **energy**, **the environment**, **climate change and anti-corruption**.
- The G20 consists of 19 countries and the European Union, representing approximately 85% of global GDP, more than 75% of global trade, and nearly two-thirds of the world's population.

- Ugadi begins with the **first day of the nine-day festival Chaitra Navratri**, and also marks the **beginning of spring**.
- It is believed that on this day **Lord Brahma** created the universe.
- The name 'Yugadi' itself is derived from the Sanskrit words yuga (age) and adi (beginning) 'the beginning of a new age'.

In the **12th century**, the Indian mathematician **Bhaskaracharya** recognized Ugadi as • the beginning of the new year.

- People from all walks of life celebrate this day by wearing new clothes and eating delicious food.
- They offer prayers at temples to welcome the new year, and they decorate their homes with rangolis, which are designs made of colored rice or flower petals on the floor.

## 8. Matua mela is being organised in West Bengal (March 20, 2023)
