## 4. WHO warns of possible rise in dengue cases in Afghanistan (May 23, 2023)

The World Health Organization (WHO) has issued an alert on the recent cases of dengue fever in Afghanistan.

### An overview of the news

- The organization said that their medical staff has enough equipment to control the disease.
- The organization said that the **number of dengue patients may increase during the rainy season.** Twelve groups of **65 women health professionals** are participating in the three-day program to protect against dengue patients.
- The WHO also urged the people of Afghanistan to avoid mosquito bites and adopt necessary safety measures to prevent dengue.

## What is Dengue?

- Commonly known as break bone fever, it is a flu-like illness caused by the dengue virus.
- It occurs when an Aedes mosquito carrying the virus bites a healthy person.
- The disease is mainly found in tropical and sub-tropical regions of the world.

## Causes of Dengue

- It is caused due to four viruses, namely DENV-1, DENV-2, DENV-3, and DENV-4.
- The virus enters the mosquito when it bites an already infected person.
- The disease is transmitted when it bites a healthy person, and the virus is spread through the person's bloodstream.

## **Symptoms of Dengue**

• Headache, Muscle, bone and joint pain, Nausea, Vomiting, swollen glands, Rash.

#### **Treatment**

- There is no specific treatment for dengue.
- Early detection of severe dengue-associated illness and access to appropriate medical care reduce deaths from severe dengue.
- Diagnosis of dengue infection is done with a blood test.

# 5. 30 percent financial support from the Center to promote green shipping ( May 23, 2023 )

Union Minister for Ports, Shipping and Waterways, **Sarbananda Sonowal** has announced **30** per cent financial assistance to promote green shipping.

### An overview of the news

- Ports, Shipping and Waterways Minister Sarbananda Sonowal made **five important** announcements focusing on green shipping and digitization of ports at the end of the second Chintan Shivir of the ministry held in Munnar, Kerala.
- Green Hydrogen hubs will be developed at the **Deendayal Port at Kandla and Chidambaranar Port at Tuticorin.**
- Two tugs each will be procured for **Jawaharlal Nehru**, **VO Chidambaranar**, **Paradip and Deendayal ports** under the Green Tug Transition Programme.
- A **single window portal** will be prepared to facilitate booking of river and sea cruises.

Jawaharlal Nehru and Turicorin ports will be made smart ports by next year.

## What is Green Shipping?

- Green shipping is when people or goods are **transported via ships** using the **minimum resources and energy possible to protect** the environment from **pollutants generated by the ships.**
- Green shipping promotes clean practices by implementing **emission control**, **efficient port management and equipment management**.

## 6. AL-MOHED AL-HINDI 2023 Naval Exercise (May 23, 2023)

AL-MOHED AL-HINDI 2023 Naval Exercise Indian Navy ships INS TARKASH and INS SUBHADRA arrived at Port Al-Jubail in Saudi Arabia on 21st May.

### An overview of the news

- The visit of these ships marks the beginning of the harbor phase of the second edition of the naval exercise between the two countries, known as 'Al-Mohad Al-Hindi 2023'.
- This year the naval exercise also includes the participation of a Maritime Patrol Aircraft.
- During the exercise, naval forces from both countries will engage in **joint maneuvers**, training activities, and exchange of expertise.
- The exercise will focus on enhancing maritime security capabilities and promoting interoperability between the two navies.
- The inaugural edition of the exercise was successfully conducted in 2021.

### About Al-Mohed Al-Hindi Exercise

- The decision on this bilateral exercise between India and Saudi Arabia was taken at the **Riyadh summit held in 2019.**

### news overview

- The trunk of the tree has a **diameter of four metres (13 ft) and it is 28 metres** tall.
- It is over 5,000 years old, surpassing the oldest tree currently known as the **Methuselah, which is 4,850 years old.**
- It is located in a forest in the **southern Los Ríos region**, 800 kilometres (500 mi) south of the **capital Santiago.**
- This tree belongs to the species **Fitzroya cupressoides**, which is also known as **Patagonian cypress.**
- Fitzroya cupressoides is the largest tree species in South America.

#### **About Chile**

- It is a long, narrow country located on the western edge of South America.
- Santiago is the capital of Chile and is located in a valley surrounded by the Santiago Andes and Chilean Coast Range mountains.
- The city's central square is called the Plaza de Armas and has palm-lined streets.
- The Plaza de Armas houses the **Neoclassical Cathedral and the National History Museum.**
- There is a huge park in Santiago called **Parque Metropolitano.**
