- He served as the Education Minister from 2017 to 2022.
- In the year 2016, the famous personality of Gambia 'Yahya Jammeh' was defeated by Badra Ali.
- He was then the fourth Vice-President to serve alongside President Adama Barrow.
- Badra Ali worked at the **World Bank** as an education specialist for West and Central Africa.
- Gambia was also in the news last year due to the death of about 70 children in the African country Gambia after consuming **cough syrup made in India.**

4. Renowned architect Dr. B.V. Doshi passed away (Jan. 25, 2023)

Noted architect and Padma Bhushan awardee **Balkrishna Doshi passed away at the age of 95.**

An overview of the news

- Regarded as the foremost architect of modern India, Doshi was born on 26 August 1927 in Pune.
- Doshi has the distinction of having worked with stalwarts in the field such as Corbusier and Louis Kahn.
- Doshi's major projects include CEPT University and Kanoria Kala Kendra in Ahmedabad, Indian Institute of Management in Bangalore and 'Aranya Low Cost Housing', a township for low and middle income families in Indore.
- Doshi was awarded the prestigious **Aga Khan Award in the year 1995 for the architecture of 'Aranya Low Cost Housing' township.**
- He was awarded the most prestigious award in the field of architecture "Pritzker" in the year 2018. He was the first Indian to receive this honour.
- Doshi was also awarded the Padma Bhushan, India's third highest civilian award in the year 2020.

5. US President Biden nominates Julie Turner as North Korea human rights envoy (Jan. 24, 2023)

US President **Joe Biden** has nominated **Julie Turner** as **special envoy for human rights** in **North Korea** on 24 January.

An overview of the news

- The move to fill the post, which has been **vacant since 2017**, comes amid debate over human rights issues as well as efforts to counter Pyongyang's nuclear weapons program.
- Julie Turner is currently the **director for East Asia and the Pacific** in the State Department's Bureau of Democracy, Human Rights and Labor.

Turner has served in the office for East Asia and the Pacific for more than 16 years,

- primarily focusing on initiatives related to the **promotion of human rights in North**Korea.
- The post of special envoy had become controversial in South Korea as the previous administration tried to bring North Korea to the negotiating table.
- Some activists said that human rights had been sidelined due to national security priorities.
- North Korea has repeatedly denied allegations of human rights abuses and blamed the sanctions for the dire humanitarian situation.
- A landmark 2014 United Nations report on North Korean human rights concluded that North Korean security chief and leader **Kim Jong Un** should face justice for Nazistyle atrocities.

6. Vikram Dev Dutt appointed as DGCA director general (Jan. 23, 2023)

The Appointments Committee of the Cabinet on 21 January approved the appointment of Vikram Dev Dutt as the next director general in the Directorate of General of Civil Aviation (DGCA).

An overview of the news

- He will take over as the chief of the aviation regulator on **February 28, 2023**. He will replace DGCA chief **Arun Kumar**.
- In 2022, Dutt was appointed by the Center as the Chairman and **Managing Director** of Air India Limited. In 2022, Air India was sold to the **Tata Group**.
- His appointment as DGCA Director General will be "in the rank and pay of Additional Secretary to the Government of India".
- Dutt is a **1993 batch IAS officer** of the AGMUT (Arunachal Pradesh, Goa, Mizoram and Union Territories) cadre.

Directorate General of Civil Aviation (DGCA)

- It is a statutory body and formed under the Aircraft (Amendment) Bill, 2020.
- It investigates aviation accidents and enforces all regulations related to aviation.
- It registers and provides certificates to civil aircrafts.
- It is attached to the **Ministry of Civil Aviation**, Government of India.
- It coordinates all regulatory functions with the **International Civil Aviation**Organisation.

7. Egyptian President Abdel Fattah El-Sisi to be Chief Guest at India's Republic Day celebrations (Jan. 22, 2023)

According to the Ministry of External Affairs, Egypt President Abdel Fattah El Sisi will be the chief quest at the 74th Republic Day celebrations.

An overview of the news

- He will pay a state visit to India from the **24th to the 26th** of this month.
- This is the first time that the President of Egypt has been invited as the chief guest on the Republic Day 2023 of India.
- A **180-member strong contingent of the Egyptian Army** will also participate in the Republic Day parade.
- The President of Egypt had earlier visited India in **October 2015** to attend the **3rd India-Africa Forum Summit**, followed by a state visit in September 2016.
- President Sisi will have a bilateral meeting and delegation-level talks with PM Modi on bilateral, regional and global issues of mutual interest.
- Abdel Fattah Sisi is a former Army officer who was elected as the president of Egypt t in **2014 and was re-elected in 2018**.

About Republic Day Celebration

- Every year Republic day is observed on **26 January.** It was on this day the constitution of India was promulgated in **1950 and India became a republic.**
- The President of India presides over the Republic day functions. It is customary to invite a foreign country leader as an honoured guest at the Republic day function.
- In **1955 Rajpath (Now Kartavya Path)** became the permanent place for the Republic day parade.
- The Chief Guest was the Governor-General of Pakistan Malik Ghulam Muhammad.
- President of Indonesia, Sukarno was the first guest at 1950 Republic day parade.

8. New Zealand's ruling Labor Party elected Chris Hipkins as the country's 41st prime minister (Jan. 22, 2023)

New Zealand's ruling Labor Party on 22 January elected **Chris Hipkins** as its leader and the country's **41st prime minister**, replacing **Ms Jacinda Ardern.**

An overview of the news

- Hipkins was the only candidate for the position and was confirmed by 64 MPs in what is known as the **Labor caucus**.
- Known as "Chippy", Hipkins played a key role in the response to COVID-19.
- He was first elected to Parliament in 2008 for the Labor Party.
- He was appointed Minister of Health in July 2020 before becoming the Minister of COVID Response.
- Before Hipkins can officially become prime minister, Ardern must submit her resignation to **King Charles III's** representative in New Zealand, Governor General **Cindy Kiro.**
- Kiro Hipkins will then be appointed to the role and sworn in.
- The Labour party has also selected Carmel Sepuloni as the deputy prime minister.
