An overview of the news

- The summit was led by Papua New Guinea's PM James Marape and PM Modi.
- As part of **India's Act East Policy**, the Prime Minister of India announced a **12-point development plan** for the Pacific Island Nations.
- The 12-point development plan focuses on a number of areas including health care, renewable energy and cyber security.
- The two leaders also launched a translation of the Tamil classic '**Thirukkural**' to the Tok Pisin language of Papua New Guinea.
- The translated book is co-authored by linguist Subha **Sasindran and Sasindran Muthuve**l, Governor of West New Britain Province of Papua New Guinea.

About FIPIC summit

- FIPIC-I, in 2014, took place at **Suva, Fiji's capital city.**
- India announced various development assistance initiatives and other cooperation projects in areas of climate change, trade, economy, telemedicine and tele education, IT, grants for community development projects, etc.
- FIPIC-II summit took place in 2015 in Jaipur.
- In 2019, the Leaders of the **Indo-Pacific Small Island Developing States** (**PSIDS**) meeting (consisting of delegations from 12 of the 14 Pacific Island countries) was held in **New York** on September 24, 2019.

7. 76th World Health Assembly at Geneva (May 23, 2023)

Union Health Minister Mansukh Mandaviya will represent India in the **76th World Health Assembly at Geneva, Switzerland** to be held from 21st to 30th May 2023.

An overview of the news

- In line with India's commitment to a healthier world, the Union Health Minister will deliver the keynote address at the side events of 'Heal in India and Heal by India' as well as 'Together We Fight Against TB'.
- During his stay till 24 May 2023, Mandaviya will participate in **various bilateral** meetings with countries across the world.
- He will promote opportunities for health-related cooperation among the participating countries.
- The bilateral meetings will engage representatives from **Singapore**, **France**, **Netherlands**, **USA**, **Bangladesh**, **Argentina**, **Brazil**, **Qatar and Bill and Melinda Gates Foundation**.
- Additionally, a multilateral meeting is also scheduled with representatives from **BRICS** (**Brazil, Russia, China and South-Africa**).

- The main functions of the World Health Assembly are to determine the policies of the Organization, appoint the Director-General, supervise financial policies, and review and approve the proposed programme budget.
- The Health Assembly is held annually in **Geneva**, **Switzerland**.

8. 2nd Trade and Investment Working Group meeting begins in Bengaluru (May 23, 2023)

2nd Trade and Investment Working Group meeting begins in Bengaluru On 23 May, the **second Trade and Investment Working Group meeting** under the G20 India Presidency began in **Bengaluru**.

An Overview of the News

- It is a three-day meeting and is attended by **75 delegates from G20 countries**, invited countries and regional/international organisations.
- The objective of the Bengaluru meeting is to address issues related to international trade and investment and seek agreeable solutions.
- Union Minister of State for Commerce and Industry **Som Prakash** inaugurated the seminar.
- The meeting discussed reforming the multilateral trading system and finding agreeable solutions for international trade and investment.
- An exhibition of Indian Startups is also a part of the event.
- The first Trade and Investment Working Group meeting was held in Mumbai.

About the G20

- It is an international forum of the world's leading economies established in 1999.
- Its **primary objective** is to promote international financial stability and sustainable economic growth.
- The G20 serves as a forum to discuss and coordinate policies related to a wide range of economic and financial issues such as trade, investment, employment, energy and climate change.
