- She is the first Indian player to get a contract in a foreign league before making her international debut.
- He has been selected to represent the Guyana Amazon Warriors in the WCPL, which will take place from 31 August to 10 September.
- Shreyanka Patil was awarded the title of 'Player of the Tournament' in the Women's Emerging Asia Cup held in Hong Kong.

- On 14 March 2022, Cricket West Indies announced the first ever women's Caribbean Premier League to be held alongside the men's tournament.

5. 132nd Durand Cup tournament organized in Kolkata (July 3, 2023)

132nd-Durand-Cup-tournamen

The "Trophy Tour" of the 132nd edition of Durand Cup, India's oldest football tournament, was flagged off on 30 June 2023 at a function held at Manekshaw Centre, Delhi Cantt.

Important Points:-

- It was flagged off by Chief of Army Staff General Manoj Pandey, Chief of Air Staff Air Chief Marshal VR Chaudhary and President of All India Football Federation (AIFF) Kalyan Choubey.
- This tournament will be organized from 03 August to 03 September 2023 in Kolkata, Guwahati, Kokrajhar and Shillong. While its final will be held in Kolkata on September 3.

Foreign teams in Durand Cup:

- 24 teams including teams from **Nepal, Bhutan and Bangladesh** will participate in the 132nd edition of the tournament.
- Foreign teams are participating in the tournament after a gap of **27 years.** The tournament is open to all club teams.
- It is organized by the Durand Football Tournament Society (DFTS) under the aegis of the All India Football Federation (AIFF).

• Basically the tournament has always been a symbol of excellence, sportsmanship and high point of competitiveness in the field of sports.

Durand Cup Tournament:

- The Durand Cup, the world's third oldest and Asia's oldest football tournament, was first held in the year **1888 at Dagshai** (Himachal Pradesh).
- It was named after **Mortimer Durand**, who was then the Foreign Secretary in charge of India.
- The tournament was initially held for British soldiers, but was later opened to civilians.
- Mohun Bagan and East Bengal are the most successful teams in the history of the Durand Cup having won it sixteen times.

6. India won the title by defeating Iran in the Asian Kabaddi Championship (June 30, 2023)

Kabaddi-Championship

India emerged victorious in the final of the Asian Kabaddi Championship 2023 held in Busan, Korea on 30th June defeating Iran with a score of 42-32.

An overview of the news

- This victory marks **India's eighth title** out of nine editions of the championship, highlighting their dominance in the sport.
- **Pawan Sehrawat**, the captain of the Indian team, played a crucial role by securing a **super 10**, leading the team to success.
- In the earlier league stage of the tournament, India showcased their prowess by defeating **Hong Kong with a comprehensive scoreline of 64-20.**
- Six teams, including **India**, **Iran**, **Japan**, **Korea**, **Chinese Taipei**, **and Hong Kong**, participated in the championship.
- India finished the league stage undefeated, winning all five matches and securing the **top position in the points table.**
- Iran, having only lost to India during the league stage, secured the second position and advanced to the final.
- The Indian kabaddi teams will now focus on the upcoming **Asian Games in Hangzhou, China,** scheduled from September 23 to October 8, where they will face a tough challenge from defending champions Iran, who defeated India in the semi-finals in Jakarta in 2018.

7. TOPS clears Wrestlers Vinesh Phogat and Bajrang Punia training in Kyrgyzstan and Hungary (June 30, 2023)

The Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports has given its approval to wrestlers Vinesh

Phogat and **Bajrang Punia** for their training proposals under the **Target Olympic Podium Scheme (TOPS).**

An overview of the news

- Vinesh Phogat will be accompanied by physiotherapist **Ashwini Jeevan Patil**, sparring partner **Sangeeta Phogat**, and Coach **Sudesh** during her training sessions.
- Bajrang Punia will be accompanied by Coach Sujeet Maan, Physiotherapist Anuj Gupta, sparring partner Jitender, and Strength and Conditioning expert Kaazi Hasan.

Target Olympic Podium Scheme (TOPS)

- It was created in **July 2014** under the auspices of the **National Sports Development Fund (NSDF)** with the objective of identifying and preparing potential medal prospects for the **Olympic and Paralympic Games**.
- It is a flagship program of the Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports.
- The idea of the scheme is to look to the future and fund a developmental group of athletes who have the potential to bring medals to the Olympic Games in **Paris in 2024** and Los Angeles in 2028.

8. Kolkata Team Emerges Victorious in Historic Dubai Women's Kabaddi Final (June 29, 2023)
