3. Ravina wins gold and Kirti settle for silver as Indian campaign ends with 11 medals at the IBA Youth Men's and Women's World Championships 2022 (Nov. 27, 2022)

Ravina wins gold and Kirti settle for silver in IBA Youth Men's and Women's World Championships 2022

The Indian boxers ended their campaign in the IBA (International Boxing Association) Youth Men's and Women's World Championships 2022 with **11 medals** with Ravina winning a gold while Kirti had to settle for the silver medal on the final day of the championship. The Indian won **4 gold medals, 3 silver medals and 4 bronze medals**.

In the final day of the championships 2022 Asian Youth gold medallist **Ravina** (63Kg) won the gold medal for India by defeating Megan deCler of the Netherlands.

Kirti (81+kg) lost her final match against the 2022 European Youth champion Cliona Elizabeth D'Arcy of Ireland, and secured the silver medal.

5. The Madras Boating club women team wins the Adyar Trophy at the 81st Annual Madras-Colombo Rowing Regatta (Nov. 26, 2022)

The Madras Boating Club women won the 81st Annual Madras-Colombo Rowing Regatta held at Colombo, Sri Lanka on 26 November 2022. They were conferred the **Adyar Trophy**.

However the **men's section** of the race was won by the Colombo Rowing Club and they were conferred with the **Deepam trophy**...

The Madras-Colombo Rowing Regatta is organised by the Madras Boat Club and the Colombo Rowing Club. They organise it alternately and this year the event is taking place after a gap of 3 years due to the corona pandemic.

Madras-Colombo Rowing Regatta

The first-ever Madras-Colombo Rowing Regatta was held way back in 1898 and is considered the **oldest sporting encounter** held between India and Sri Lanka.

The main event of the Regatta is the Men's boat race which is considered to be the **second oldest boat race** in the world, second only to the famous Oxford-Cambridge boat race.

The overall winners of the Men's event are awarded the prestigious **Deepam Trophy** while the **Adyar Trophy** is awarded to the Women's champions.

The boat race is held for a distance of 1,000 meters.

6. Vishwanath, Vanshaj, Devika wins gold medals at Youth World Boxing Championships 2022 (Nov. 26, 2022)

Indian boxers **Vishwanath Suresh, Vanshaj** and **Devika Ghorpade** won gold medals at the IBA(International Boxing Association) Youth Men's and Women's World Championships 2022 in **La Nucia, Spain** on 25 November 2022.

Vishwanath Suresh from Chennai won his gold medal by defeating Ronel Suyom of Philippines in the men's 48kg final.

Devika from Pune won the second gold for India on the day by defeating England's Lauren Mackie in the women's 52kg final.

Asian Youth champion **Vanshaj** from Sonipat won the third gold medal by defeating Demur Kajaia of Georgia in the men's 63.5kg final.

India with 11 medals is leading the medal tallies followed by Uzbekistan.

7. Cristiano Ronaldo becomes first player to score in 5 different World Cups (Nov. 26, 2022)

Cristiano Ronaldo becomes first player to score in 5 different World Cups

Portugal captain **Cristiano Ronaldo** became the **first player to score in 5 different World Cups** when he scored the first goal against **Ghana** in the FIFA World Cup on 24 November.

Important facts

- In the first match of Group H, Portugal captain Ronaldo scored the first goal in the 65th minute, becoming the first male footballer to score in five different World Cups (2006, 2010, 2014, 2018, 2022).
- With this record, Ronaldo has left behind Pele of Brazil, Uwe Seeler of Germany and Miraslov Klose who have scored goals in four World Cups.
- 37-year-old Cristiano Ronaldo has increased his international goal count to 118. He scored his eighth career World Cup goal in a 3-2 win against Ghana.
- Cristiano Ronaldo scored three goals in 15 minutes as Portugal beat Ghana 3-2 in their FIFA World Cup Group H match to open their campaign on a winning note.

- Earlier this month, Petrie won his maiden **National U-13 ranking tournament** in Maharashtra with a dominant performance against Agra's Gautam.
- In the boys' final, **Bhukya** found it difficult to handle Boba in the first game as the Andhra shuttler raced to a 15-11 lead before winning the game 21-19.
