- The deputies also elected 18 members to the Council of State, including eight reelections and ten new appointments.

An overview of the news

- The exercise will be conducted at the Andravida Air Base in Greece from 24 Apr 2023 to 4 May 2023.
- The Indian Air Force will be participating with **four Su-30 MKI and two C-17**
- The exercise will be conducted in a **realistic combat scenario** involving a wide variety of air and surface assets.

It will also enable participating parties to engage in professional interactions, providing valuable insight into each other's best practices.

• The exercise aims to enhance **international cooperation**, **synergy and interoperability** among the participating air forces.

About exercise INIOCHOS-23

- This exercise to be held at **Greece's Andravida Air Base** is considered to be **Europe's biggest air exercise**.
- Many countries like **France**, **Italy** are participating in this. **The Indian Air Force will** participate in this exercise for the first time.
- The exercise will see participation of air assets from countries like France, USA, Italy,
 Saudi Arabia and Jordan apart from India's Su-30MKIs.

4. EU-India Aviation Summit begins in New Delhi (April 20, 2023)

The two day European Union (EU)-India Aviation Summit began in New Delhi on 20th April.

An overview of the news

- During the summit, a declaration of intent was signed by the Airport Authority of India with Eurocontrol.
- A letter of intent memorandum of understanding was also signed by DGCA with the European Union Aviation Safety for closer cooperation.
- The Union Minister of Civil Aviation and Steel Jyotiraditya Scindia addressed the summit virtually.
- The summit focused on the EU-India air transport relationship and the mutually shared challenges and opportunities of the two regions.
- The theme of the summit was COVID recovery of air traffic, increasing sustainability, maintaining safety and development of unmanned aircraft systems.

6. Prime Minister Narendra Modi inaugurated the first Global Buddhist Summit (April 20, 2023)

Prime Minister Narendra Modi inaugurated the first Global Buddhist Summit

On 20 April, Prime Minister Narendra Modi inaugurated the <u>first Global Buddhist</u>
<u>Summit</u> in New Delhi. Summit was hosted by the Ministry of Culture in association with the International Buddhist Confederation.

An Overview of the news

- The summit is a two-day event that brought together **eminent scholars**, **union leaders and religious practitioners** from around the world.
- Theme: "Responses to Contemporary Challenges: Philosophy to Praxis".
- The summit was attended by delegates from around 30 countries, including 171 delegates from foreign countries and 150 delegates from Indian Buddhist organisations.
- The primary focus of the summit is to examine the teachings of **Shakyamuni Buddha**, which have been continuously enriched by the practice of Buddhism over the centuries.
- Prominent Buddhist monks from various countries came to India for the first time and participated in the summit.
- The summit will explore how **Buddhist philosophy and thought** can help address contemporary challenges.
- The summit highlights the significance and importance of India in Buddhism, as **Buddhism originated in India.**
- The summit is also an opportunity to enhance cultural and diplomatic ties with other countries.

Buddhism in India

- It is one of the important religions of **South and South-Eastern Asian countries.**
- Buddhism started in India about 2600 years ago.
- Gautam Buddha, the founder of Buddhism, was **born in Lumbini around 563 BC**. He belonged to the **Shakya dynasty.**

- Buddha is considered to be the **eighth incarnation of the ten incarnations of*** Lord Vishnu.
- The core teachings of Buddhism are contained in the Four Noble Truths and the core concept of the Eightfold Path.
- The essence of Buddhism lies in the attainment of **enlightenment or nirvana**, which can be achieved in this life.
- The branches of Buddhism are Mahayana (idolatry), Hinayana, Theravada, Vajrayana (Tantric Buddhism), and Zen.

- India has been actively participating in the SCO and providing substantial support to various mechanisms in the Forum.
- India is focusing on initiating proposals of mutual benefit to SCO member states, observers and dialogue partners.

About Shanghai Cooperation Organization (SCO)

- It is an intergovernmental organisation established in 2001 in Shanghai, China.
- The organisation consists of eight member states, including **China**, **Russia**, **Kazakhstan**, **Kyrgyzstan**, **Tajikistan**, **Uzbekistan**, **India**, and **Pakistan**.
- The purpose of the SCO is to promote regional cooperation in the fields of **politics**, **security**, **economy**, **culture and education**.
- The organisation serves as a forum for member states to engage in regular **dialogue** and consultation on issues of mutual interest.

- The SCO has been instrumental in promoting regional security and stability by countering
- terrorism, extremism and separatism.
- The organisation has observer states and dialogue partners, including countries such as **Afghanistan, Iran, Belarus and Mongolia**.

8. 8th India-Thailand Defence Dialogue (April 20, 2023)

8th India-Thailand Defence Dialogue

The 8th India-Thailand Defence Dialogue was held in Bangkok on 20th April.

An overview of the news

- The meeting was co-chaired by **Nivedita Shukla**, Special Secretary in the Ministry of Defense and **General Nuchit Sribunsong**, Deputy Permanent Secretary of Defense of Thailand.
- They reviewed defence cooperation between the two countries and explored **new** initiatives to further strengthen bilateral ties.
- The two sides also exchanged views on regional and global issues of common interest.
- India and Thailand share a **strategic partnership and defense** is a major pillar of this cooperation.

India-Thailand relations

- India and Thailand share a maritime boundary in the Andaman Sea.
- Thailand was one of the first countries to establish **diplomatic relations with India** in 1947.
- Since 2001, **India-Thailand economic and commercial relations** have grown significantly.
- India and Thailand have been cooperating in various multilateral fora such as ASEAN and BIMSTEC, a sub-regional grouping consisting of Bangladesh, India, Sri Lanka, Thailand, Myanmar, Nepal and Bhutan.
- India is a member of the **Asia Cooperation Dialogue (ACD**) initiated by Thailand in 2002 and the **Mekong-Ganga Cooperation (MGC)** grouping of six countries.
- The **India-AESAN Agreement on Trade in Goods** was implemented in January 2010.
- Since 2015, India has been participating in the largest Asia Pacific military exercise **X-Cobra Gold.**
- Exercise MAITREE (Army) and exercise SIAM BHARAT (Air Force) are Bilateral exercises between both countries.

- There will be a **QR code under this system, through which the seeds can be traced.**
- Training in this regard is being imparted through the **Indian Council of Agricultural Research (ICAR)**, Krishi Vigyan Kendras, State Governments.
- All the states will be connected with the Seed Traceability System.
- Sathi portal will ensure quality assurance system, identify the source of seed in the seed production chain.

10. Union Cabinet Approves National Quantum Mission (April 19, 2023)

Union Cabineton 19th April approved the **National Quantum Mission** to nurture and scale up scientific and **industrial research and development in quantum technology.**

An overview of the news

- The Union Cabinet approved **Rs 6,003.65 crore** for the mission from 2023-24 to 2030-31.
- The Mission will accelerate quantum technology-led economic growth and nurture the ecosystem in the country.
- The Mission will be implemented by the **Department of Science and Technology** in partnership with other departments.
- India will be the sixth country to have a dedicated quantum mission after the US,
 Austria, Finland, France and China.
- The mission will help develop **high-sensitivity magnetometers in nuclear systems and atomic clocks for precise timing,** communication and navigation.
- The mission envisages developing an intermediate-scale quantum computer with a capacity of 50-1000 physical qubits in eight years on various platforms such as superconducting and photonic techniques.

What is Quantum Technology?

- Quantum technology is based on quantum theory, which explains the nature of energy and matter at the atomic and sub-atomic level.
- With the help of this technology, data and information can be **processed in minimum time.**
