India women's cricket team captain **Harmanpreet Kaur** and **Pakistan wicket-keeper batsman Mohammad Rizwan** won the **ICC Player of the Month awards** for September-2022 in the **women's and men's categories**.

- The ICC Men's Player of the Month nominees included **Australia's Cameron Green** and **India's Axar Patel**, but Pakistan's **Mohammad Rizwan** managed to bag the ICC Men's Player of the Month award for the first time.

India will host the 3rd WADA(World Anti-Doping Agency) Athlete Biological Passport (ABP) Symposium- 2022” in **New Delhi** from 12-14 October 2022.The Union Minister for Youth Affairs & Sports **Anurag Singh Thakur** will address the opening session of the Symposium.

The 3rd WADA (World Anti-Doping Agency) Athlete Biological Passport (ABP) Symposium-2022” is being organised by the **National Anti-Doping Agency (NADA)** and **National Dope Testing Laboratory (NDTL)**.

The first WADA ABP Symposium was hosted by **Qatar** in 2015 and the second was hosted by **Italy** at Rome in 2018.

Two hundred plus participants from 56 Countries, WADA Officials, representatives and Experts from different National Anti-Doping Organizations, Athlete Passport Management Units (APMUs) and WADA Accredited Laboratories are participating in this Symposium.

## **10. FIFA Under-17 Women's World Cup 2022 begins today ( Oct. 11, 2022 )**

**FIFA U-17 Women's World Cup 2022** started from **11 October 2022**. After successfully hosting the Under-17 men's FIFA World Cup in 2019, India is now hosting the tournament.

### **Important facts**

- **India will take on USA** in their Group-A opening match at the **Kalinga Stadium in Bhubaneswar** on October 11.
- This is the **seventh edition** of the FIFA U-17 Women's World Cup.
- **North Korea** is the tournament's **most successful country**, having won **two titles** since its inception in 2008.
- Previous winners are **South Korea, France, Japan, and Spain**.
- **Spain** are the **defending champions**, having won the **2018 tournament in Uruguay** after **defeating Mexico in the final**.
- The tournament will take place from 11th to 30th October 2022, in **Bhubaneshwar, Navi Mumbai and Goa**.
