1. Novak Djokovic won the French Open 2023 Men's Singles Final (June 12, 2023)

Novak-Djokovic

In Tennis, Serbian Novak Djokovic won the French Open 2023 men's singles final, clinching his 23rd Grand Slam title.

An Overview of the News

- Novak Djokovic has become the first man to reach the 23rd Grand Slam title.
- He won the title by defeating Casper Rudd in straight sets.
- The win gives Djokovic his **third French Open title** and surpasses **Rafael Nadal's** record for most title wins.
- He overtook Rafael Nadal as the oldest **Roland Garros champion** at the age of 36 years and 20 days.
- He also became the first person to win all **four Grand Slam** events at least three times.

2. FIH Pro League 2023: India beat Argentina 2-1 in final match at Eindhoven in Netherlands (June 12, 2023)

The Indian hockey team beat Argentina 2-1 in its final FIH Pro League 2022-23 match in Eindhoven, the Netherlands, on 11 June.

An overview of the news

- Akashdeep Singh and Sukhjeet Singh scored goals for India while Lucas Toscani netted the only goal for Argentina.
- With the win in this tie, India have further consolidated their top spot in the FIH Pro League 2022-23 points table with **30 points** from **16 matches**. While **Argentina are fifth** in the table with **13 points from 14 matches**.
- India now lead second-placed Great Britain by four points in the **FIH Pro League 2022-23** standings but the European team still has four games to play.
- The Indian men's hockey team finished fourth in their maiden FIH Pro League campaign in 2020-21. At the same time, in this competition, it achieved the third position in the 2021-22 season, performing best.

3. French Open: Iga Swiatek of Poland wins Women's Singles title (June 11, 2023)

In French Open tennis, World No 1 and top seed Iga Swiatek of Poland has won the Women's Singles crown at Paris on 10th June.

An overview of the news

- She defended her title against unseeded **Czech Republic's Karolina Muchova** 6-2, 5-7, 6-4. This is her **third French title** in just 5 years.
- Poland's Iga Swiatek became the first woman since 2007 to win back-to-back French Open titles.
- The 22-year-old Swiatek is just the **third woman** in the Open era to **win each of her first four Grand Slam finals.**
- Monica Seles and Naomi Osaka are the only other players to achieve this feat.
- Swiatek, the world number 1, is also the **youngest woman** to claim back-to-back French Open titles since Monica Seles in the early 1990s.

4. Paris Diamond League: India's Murali Sreeshankar finishes third in long jump (June 10, 2023)

Murali-Sreeshankar-finishes-third-in-long-jump India's Murali Sreeshankar finished third with an impressive effort of 8.09m in the men's long jump event at the Paris Diamond League 2023 in France on June 9.

An overview of the news

- Murali made his best jump on the night of 8 June in his third attempt.
- An effort of **8.09 m placed him in second place**, only behind reigning **Olympic and Diamond League champion Miltiadis Tantoglu** of Greece who won the **Paris Diamond League** with a jump of 8.13 m.
- A foul by Murali in the **fourth attempt and a jump of 8.11m** by **Switzerland's Simon Ehmer** pushed the Indian long jumper to third place.
- This was Sreesankar's **second appearance** in the Diamond League.
- Last year in Monaco, he finished sixth with an effort of 7.94m.
- His personal best jump is **8.36m** which he did last year.
- Notably, India's national record in the men's long jump is held by **Jessvin Aldrin**, who cleared 8.42m earlier this year.
- The 24-year-old **Sreeshankar** entered the Paris leg of the Diamond League on the back of three gold medals in a row.
- He had won the **World Athletics Continental Tour** bronze in Kallithea, Greece last month with a season's best jump of **8.18m.**

5. Sunil Kumar wins decathlon gold at Asian U20 Athletics Championships (June 9, 2023)

Sunil-Kumar

Sunil Kumar, representing India, won the **gold medal** with a score of 7003 points in the men's decathlon event at the **Asian U20 Athletics Championships** in **Yecheon, South Korea**.

An Overview of the News

- In the women's high jump event, **Pooja** won the **silver medal** with a jump of 1.82 metres.
- Bushra Khan earned a silver medal in the women's 3000m race.
- The Indian women's 4x100m relay team won the bronze medal with a timing of 45.36 seconds.
- **Siddharth Chowdhary** won the gold medal in the men's shot put event with a throw of 19.52 metres.
- In the javelin throw event, **Shivam Lohakare** won the silver medal with a throw of 72.34 metres.
- **Sharuk Khan** added another silver to India's tally in the men's 3000m steeplechase with a timing of 8:51.74.
- **Sushmita** earned a silver medal in the long jump event.

In the medal table, India has secured the third position in the overall ranking.

An Overview of the News

- He achieved this feat by recording a personal best throw of 19.52 metres.
- Indian athletes **Sharuk Khan** earned a **silver medal** in the 3000 meters steeplechase event, **Shivam Lohakare** a **silver medal** in the javelin throw and **Sushmita** a **silver medal** in the long jump event.
- Apart from this, Shakeel finished third in the 800 meter race by securing a bronze medal.
- The Indian mixed relay team also put up a commendable performance, bagging another bronze medal.
- India's total medal tally has gone up to nine at the **Under-20 Asian Athletics Championships in South Korea.**

Amlan Borgohain won two gold medals at the Flanders Cup 2023 Athletics Indian athlete Amlan Borgohain won two gold medals at the Flanders Cup 2023 Athletics Meet in Merksem, Belgium.

An overview of the news

- Amlan Borgohain secured gold medals in both the men's 100m and 200m races at the Flanders Cup 2023 athletics meet.
- In the **men's 100m event**, Borgohain emerged as the **fastest man with a time of 10.70s**. Although this was **0.45s** slower than his own national record, it was enough for him to claim the gold.
- Jamaican athlete Aubrey Allen secured the silver medal in the men's 100m event with a timing of 10.80s. Victor Hofmans from Belgium finished third, clinching the bronze with a time of 11.01s.
- Borgohain continued his impressive performance in the men's 200m race, clocking an impressive time of 20.96s to claim another gold medal. Victor Hofmans of Belgium finished second with a time of 21.42s, and Samuel Rowe, a Jamaican sprinter, secured the third position with a time of 21.88s.

8. South Korea's An Se-young wins Thailand Open final (June 4, 2023)

World No. 2 Ann Se-young of South Korea claimed her fourth title in 2023 by defeating China's He Bingjiao in the women's singles final of the Thailand Open badminton tournament on lune 4.

An overview of the news

- Thailand Open Badminton was played in Bangkok.
- 21-year-old Ann Si-young won **21-10, 21-19.**
- The South Korean player has been able to make the finals of every tournament he has played this year, winning titles at the All England Open, India and Indonesia.

- She will be eyeing his **fifth title** at the **Singapore Badminton Open**, which begins at the **Indoor Stadium**.
- In the men's final, **Thailand's Kunlavut Witidson** won the **first gold** medal by defeating **Hong Kong's Lee Cheuk Yiu** 21-12, 21-10 in just 38 minutes. He became the fourth Thai man to win the tournament.

9. Bishkek Ranking Series 2023: Manisha wins gold (June 4, 2023)

Manisha, an Asian championships bronze medallist in women's 65kg, won India's first gold medal at the Bishkek Ranking Series 2023 in Kyrgyzstan 3rd May.

An overview of the news

- Reetika, who also won a bronze at the Asian championships, settled for silver in the women's 72kg event.
- Sarita Mor, a former Asian champion and 2021 world championships bronze medallist, clinched a bronze in women's 59kg.
- With the three medals from Indian women wrestlers, India's tally at the ongoing Ranking Series reached four. Greco-Roman wrestler Manjeet (55kg) won bronze earlier.
- Manisha competed in the nordic round system and remained unbeaten in her four matches, defeating opponents from Kazakhstan, Mongolia, and Ukraine to secure gold.
- Reetika won her bout against **Italy's Dalma Caneva** but lost to **Kazakhstan's Zhamila Bakbergenova**, settling for silver in the women's 72kg event.
- Sarita Mor secured bronze after defeating Kazakhstan's Diana Kayumova via technical superiority.
- Indian Greco-Roman wrestlers **Sajan (77kg) and Vikas (72kg**) reached the medal round but lost their matches.

10. India won the Men's Junior Asia Cup 2023 title in Hockey (June 2, 2023)

India-won-the-Men's-Junior-Asia-Cup-2023-title-in-Hockey India won the Men's Junior Asia Cup 2023 title in Hockey by defeating Pakistan 2-1 in the final held in Salalah, Oman.

An Overview of the News

- The win marked India's fourth title in the men's Junior Asia Cup, having previously won in 2004, 2008 and 2015.
- Angad Bir Singh and Arjit Hundal Singh scored for India, while Pakistan managed to score a goal through Basharat Ali.
- In the semi-finals, India defeated Republic of Korea 9–1, while Pakistan defeated Malaysia 6–2 to enter the final.

Pakistan are the second most successful team in the men's junior Asia Cup with three

• titles, but their last win was 27 years ago in 1996.

Men's Hockey Junior Asia Cup

- It is an international under-21 field hockey tournament organized by the **Asian Hockey Federation (AHF).**
- The tournament has been held annually since 1988 and serves as a qualifying event for the men's FIH Hockey Junior World Cup.
- To participate in the tournament, players must be under 21 years of age as of 31 December of the year preceding the tournament.
