1. "Locked Shields" cyber-defense exercise 2023 to be held by NATO in Tallinn (April 24, 2023)

The 2023 edition of the annual exercise "Locked Shields" was hosted by the NATO Cooperative Cyber Defense Center of Excellence in Tallinn (Estonia).

An Overview of the News

- "Locked Shields" is an annual cyber defence exercise hosted by the NATO Cooperative Cyber Defense Center of Excellence in Tallinn. The exercise started on 18 April 2023.
- More than **3000 participants from 38 countries** including **NATO allies** and partners took part in the exercise.
- The exercise simulates **real-time attacks and tests strategic decision making** in critical situations.
- The exercise highlights the importance of **international collaboration and** cooperation in the field of cyber defence.
- The **NATO Cooperative Cyber Defense Center of Excellence** helps participating countries and organisations improve their cyber defence capabilities.

About Locked Shields

- It is an annual cyber defence exercise that simulates a large-scale cyber incident.
- Rapid Reaction Teams from different countries work together to assist a fictional nation in managing a **massive cyber attack**.
- Blue Teams made up of **CCDCOE member nations protect** the mock state's information systems and critical infrastructure from thousands of attacks.
- The aim of the exercise is to improve the skills and capabilities of the participating teams and enhance international cooperation and communication in cyber defence.
- The exercise includes both defensive and offensive operations, with Red Teams simulating attacks and Blue Teams defending.

2. Air Marshal Sandeep Singh appointed Military Advisor to National Security Council (April 23, 2023)

Air Marshal Sandeep Singh appointed Military Advisor to National Security Council

Former Vice Chief of the Air Staff Air Marshal Sandeep Singh (Retd) has been appointed as the **new Military Advisor to the National Security Council Secretariat** (NSCS). He will assume charge on April 24.

An overview of the news

- He will replace General Anil Chauhan, who was appointed Chief of Defense Staff in October last year.
- Sandeep Singh retired as the Vice Chief of the Air Force on January 31, 2023, after a military career of four decades.
- Sandeep Singh, an alumnus of the National Defense Academy, who was appointed as the new military advisor in the National Security Council Secretariat, was commissioned into the Indian Air Force in December 1983 as a fighter pilot.
- He has flown a number of aircraft, and has close to 4,900 hours of operational and test flying experience on Su-30 MKI, MiG-29, MiG-21, AN-32, Avro, Jaguar and Mirage 2000.
- He also played a key role in the **induction**, **production** and **arming of the Su-30 MKI** aircraft in India.
- In recognition of his services of an exceptionally high order, he was awarded the Vayu Sena Medal in 2006, the Ati Vishisht Seva Medal in 2013 and the Param Vishisht Seva Medal in 2022.

3. DRDO and Indian Navy Conduct Successful Trial of BMD Interceptor (April 23, 2023)

Defence Research and Development Organisation (DRDO) and Indian Navy successfully

Defence Research and Development Organisation (DRDO) and Indian Navy successfully conducted a maiden flight trial of sea-based endo-atmospheric interceptor missile off the coast of Odisha in the Bay of Bengal on April 21.

An overview of the news

- The objective of the test was to target and destroy the effect of an enemy ballistic missile threat.
- The test could place the Indian Navy in an elite club of nations with BMD capabilities.
- Earlier, DRDO had successfully demonstrated the capability of the surface-based BMD system and thus achieved the capability to neutralize incoming ballistic missile threats from the enemy.

Defence Research and Development Organisation (DRDO)

- It is a premier defence research and development agency under the **Ministry of Defence, Government of India.**
- It is working on several cutting-edge military technology areas, including aeronautics, armaments, combat vehicles, electronics, instrumentation, engineering systems, missiles, materials, naval systems, advanced computing, simulation, cyber, hypersonic technology, quantum computing and communications
- DRDO's first project for the Indian military was in surface-to-air missiles (SAM) known as **Project Indigo.**
- Since inception, DRDO has made several breakthroughs in developing key systems and critical technologies such as aircraft avionics, UAVs, small arms, artillery systems, EW systems, tanks and armoured vehicles, sonar systems, command and control systems and missile systems
- It aims to make India self-reliant in critical **defence technology and systems.**
- It was set up in **1958.**

5. Exercise INIOCHOS-23 (April 21, 2023)

The Indian Air Force (IAF) will be participating in Exercise INIOCHOS-23, a multinational air exercise hosted by the Hellenic Air Force, the air force of Greece.

An overview of the news

- The exercise will be conducted at the Andravida Air Base in Greece from 24 Apr 2023 to 4 May 2023.
- The Indian Air Force will be participating with **four Su-30 MKI and two C-17** aircraft.
- The exercise will be conducted in a **realistic combat scenario** involving a wide variety of air and surface assets.
- It will also enable participating parties to engage in professional interactions, providing valuable insight into each other's best practices.

Objective of Exercise INIOCHOS-23

• The exercise aims to enhance **international cooperation**, **synergy and interoperability** among the participating air forces.

About exercise INIOCHOS-23

- This exercise to be held at **Greece's Andravida Air Base** is considered to be **Europe's biggest air exercise**.
- Many countries like **France**, **Italy** are participating in this. **The Indian Air Force will** participate in this exercise for the first time.
- The exercise will see participation of air assets from countries like **France**, **USA**, **Italy**, **Saudi Arabia and Jordan** apart from India's Su-30MKIs.

An Overview of the News:

• The main objective of this exercise is to live up to the high standards during the war and understand all the dimensions of air attack.

Organized in three phases:

- It will be organized from 18 April to 8 May 2023 in three phases:
 - Phase I: April 18 to 23
 - Phase II: April 24 to May 4
 - Phase III: May 5 to May 8

Countries participating in Iniochos-2023:

 In this, apart from India and Greece, fighter aircraft of many countries like America, France, Italy, Jordan, Saudi Arabia, Slovenia, Cyprus, Spain will also be included.

India's eye on F-16 fighter aircraft:

• During this, the Indian Air Force will get an opportunity to practice with the F-16 fighter aircraft (this aircraft is also with Pakistan). He will get a full opportunity to test his ability and skill during the battle. Whereas, there is still no official information from India.

These will be practiced:

• In this exercise, offensive counter operation, defensive counter operation, strategic air operation, exercise of air support to ground forces, exercise of air support to navy, search, combat search and rescue, exercise of destruction of vital targets of the enemy, there will also be an exercise to protect your important bases.

Highlights of the Iniochos-2023 exercise:

- Apart from India's Sukhoi Su-30MKI fighter aircraft, Greece's F-16 and Rafale fighter jets, Cyprus' AW-139 helicopters, France's Rafale, Italy's Tornado, Jordan's F-16, Saudi Arabia's AU- 15, Slovenia's PC-9, Spain's EF-18 and America's MQ-9 Reaper drones will participate.
- Apart from this, officers from Austria and Canada will witness the entire exercise.

8. Exercise Cope India 2023 (April 10, 2023)

Exercise Cope India 2023, a bilateral air force exercise between the Indian Air Force (IAF) and the United States Air Force (USAF), is being held at Air Force Stations Arjan Singh (Panagarh), Kalaikunda (West Bengal) and Agra from 10 April.

An Overview of the News:

- The **aim** of the exercise is to enhance mutual understanding between the two air forces and to share their best practices.
- The first phase of this exercise has started on 10 April 2023. This phase of the exercise will focus on air mobility and will involve transport aircraft and special forces assets from both the air forces.
- Both countries will field C-130J and C-17 aircraft in the exercise, along with USAF MC-130J operations.
- The exercise also features the presence of **Japanese Air Self Defense Force personnel**, who will participate in the capacity of observers.
- The first **Cope India exercise** was held in the year 2004 at **Tekanpur, Air Force Station, Gwalior.**

9. Joint Military Exercise 'Ex KAVACH' concludes at Andaman and Nicobar Command (April 9, 2023)

The Andaman and Nicobar Command (ANC) conducted a large-scale joint military exercise 'X Kavach' involving assets of the Army, Navy, Air Force and Coast Guard.

An overview of the news

- Commencing on 23 February 2023, the exercise concluded on 7 April 2023.
- The exercise was aimed at fine-tuning joint combat capabilities and **Standard Operating Procedures (SOPs)** and enhancing interoperability and operational synergy between the armies.
- Army's 'Shatrujit Brigade', Armed Forces Special Operations Division
 (AFSOD), Navy's Special Forces and ANC's amphibious troops carried out an
 exercise at a remote island in the Andaman and Nicobar Islands.
- The exercise featured multi-domain exercises involving **amphibious landings**, airborne operations, heliborne operations and rapid entry of special forces off the coast.
- 'X Kavach' showcased the capabilities and preparedness of the Armed Forces to safeguard India's maritime interests and ensure the security of the Andaman and Nicobar Islands.

- The aircraft was flown by **Group Captain Naveen Kumar,** Commanding Officer of **106 Squadron.**
- The aircraft flew at an altitude of about two kilometers above sea level and at a speed of about 800 kilometers per hour.
- The President's flight in the Sukhoi 30 MKI fighter aircraft is a part of his efforts to engage with the armed forces as the Supreme Commander of the Indian Armed Forces.

Country's second President to fly in fighter jet

- President **Draupadi Murmu** is the **second President** of the country to fly in **Sukhoi MKI 30 fighter jet** and the **fourth President** of the country to fly in a fighter aircraft.
- Earlier, former President **Dr. APJ Abdul Kalam, Pratibha Patil and Ramnath Kovind** have flown in Indian Air Force fighter aircraft.
- Before President Draupadi Murmu, country's first woman President Pratibha Patil flew in Sukhoi in 2009.
