1. Antim Panghal wins bronze medal at World Championships (Sept. 22, 2023)

Young Indian wrestler Antim Panghal won a bronze medal in the women's 53 kg category at the World Championships in Belgrade, Serbia.

An Overview of the News

- Panghal's victory also secured a quota for India in the 2024 Paris Olympics.
- In the bronze medal match, Panghal defeated two-time European champion Emma Jonna Denise Malmgren by a score of 16-6, India's first medal in the ongoing edition of the World Championships.
- This achievement added India's total medal tally at the World Championships to 23, which includes one gold, five silver, and 17 bronze medals.

Antim Panghal's Remarkable Journey to Bronze Medal:

- She started by defeating the 2022 world champion, Dominique Olivia Parrish of the United States, in the opening round by a score of 3-2.
- Panghal continued her winning streak by defeating Roxana Marta Zasina of Poland in the round of 16.

2. Priya Malik wins gold at U20 World Wrestling Championships in Jordan (Aug. 19, 2023)

An Overview of the News

• The win makes Priya Malik only the second Indian woman to earn a gold medal in this prestigious competition.

- Competing in the 76 kg category, Priya showed her prowess by defeating Germany's Laura Kuehn with a decisive score of 5-0 in the gold medal match.

- Priya Malik's success has contributed to India's outstanding performance at the U20 World Wrestling Championships under the Target Olympic Podium Scheme (TOPS).
- This win is the second time that India has earned two gold medals in the same championship. **The last time this happened was in 2001.**

Bronze medal of athlete Arju

- Along with Priya's win, another Indian wrestler named Arju, who is part of the Khelo India initiative, showcased her skills in the 68 kg category.
- Arju's achievement includes winning the bronze medal after defeating Turkey's Elif Kurt in the bronze medal match.

Impressive medal tally for India

The country's medal tally totaled twelve medals: four gold, two silver, and six bronze.

3. India won total 14 medals in Asian Wrestling Championship 2023 (April 18, 2023)

India participated in the **36th edition of Asian Wrestling Championship to be held in Astana, Kazakhstan** from 9th to 14th April 2023. The event was originally planned to be held in New Delhi, India.

An Overview of the News

- A total of **331 wrestlers from 22 countries** participated in this competition, out of which **30 wrestlers were from India.**
- Indian wrestlers were successful in winning a total of 14 medals in the championship. This includes one gold, three silver and ten bronze medals.
- With these achievements, India secured the 7th position in the medal tally.
- The top three nations in the medal table based on gold medals were **Kazakhstan**, **Japan and Iran**.
- The previous edition of the Asian Wrestling Championships, the **35th edition, was** held in Ulaanbaatar, Mongolia from April 19 to April 24 in 2022.

4. Indian female wrestler Antim Panghal nominated for United World Wrestling Rising Star of the Year honour (Dec. 24, 2022)

India's female wrestler, Antim Panghal, has been nominated for the honour of United World Wrestling 2022 Rising Star of the Year.

Important facts

- Antim Panghal created history in August this year by earning India's first gold medal at the World U20 Wrestling Championships 2022.
- She beat **Germany's Amory Olivia Andrich** 11–0 on her way to the top of the podium, and beat Kazakhstan's U20 Asian medalist **Altyn Shagayeva** in the 53kg final.
- Antim Panghal participated in four international competitions this year for different age groups. She finished the season with 16 wins and just one loss.
- She earned gold medals in the U20 World Championships, U20 Asian Championships, and the senior category competition known as the **Zouhaier Sghaier Ranking** Series.

5. Antim Panghal nominated for the United World Wrestling 2022 Rising Star of the Year award (Dec. 22, 2022)

Indian women's wrestler **Antim Panghal** has been nominated for United World Wrestling 2022 **Rising Star of the Year award.** Japan's **Nonoka Ozaki,** USA's **Amit Elor,** Sweden's **Emma Malmgren** and **Andreea Ana** of Romania are the other in the five-woman nominees list for the United World Wrestling 2022 Rising Star of the Year award.

Antim Panghal created history this year by winning India's first-ever gold medal at the **World U20 Wrestling Championships 2022** in August. The 18-year-old freestyle wrestler from Haryana is also the reigning Asian champion in the same age category. She also won the senior category event, Zouhaier Sghaier Ranking Series.

19 year old **Nonoka Ozaki** of Japan has won gold medals in the senior world championships and the Asian championship this year in the 62 kg category.

18 year old American wrestler **Amit Elor,** is the reigning U23 and the senior world champion in 72kg.

21 year old **Emma Malmgren** of Sweden is world No. 4 in 53kg and is the European champion in seniors. **Andreea Ana** of Romania is the senior European champion in the 55kg.

It is the international governing body of amateur wrestling in the world. It was earlier known as the FILA (Fédération *Internationale des Luttes Associées*) or International Federation of Amateur Wrestling.

6. Wrestler Antim Panghal becomes first ever Indian woman to win gold at U20 World Championships (Aug. 20, 2022)

Antim Panghal created history as she became the first Indian female wrestler ever to clinch gold at the Under 20 Wrestling World Championships.

IMPORTANT FACTS -

- She defeated Altyn Shagayeva of Kazakhstan 8-0 in the final of the 53kg weight category.
- She topped the podium in the 53kg category at the World Championships being held in Sofia, Bulgaria on 18 August.
- Six other Indian wrestlers have reached the finals of the Under-20 World Championships before Panghal, but the 17-year-old Panghal is the first Indian woman to win gold.
- Prior to this, she has won bronze at the Cadet World Championships (2021) and gold at the Asian Junior Championships (2022).
- He also won a silver medal at the Under 23 Asian Championship this year.
- It is being held in Sofia, Bulgaria from 15 to 21 August 2022.
