1. India, China leads as Global intellectual property filings reached new records in 2021: WIPO (Nov. 22, 2022)

India. China leads as Global intellectual

According to the **World Intellectual Property Organisation Indicators report** published by the World Intellectual Property Organisation (WIPO on 21 November 2022, Global intellectual property filings of <u>patents</u>, <u>trademarks</u>, <u>and designs</u>, reached record levels in 2021 driven largely by increases from Asian countries of India, China, and South Korea.

The WIPO's World Intellectual Property Indicators (WIPI) report showed that innovators around the world filed **3.4 million patent** applications in 2021, up 3.6 per cent from the previous year with offices in Asia receiving 67.6 percent of all applications worldwide.

According to the report the growth in registering new brands coincided with a boom in entrepreneurial activity and venture capital deals prompted by the corona pandemic's disruptions. Industrial design filing activity rose by 9.2 per cent. The largest growth in designs was also from offices in Asia.

Asia leads while US declines

According to the report, local filings of patents in India grew by **5.5%**, in China it grew by 5.5%, and in South Korea by 2.5%. More than two-thirds of the patents filed were from Asia.

According to the report, in 2021 the local patenting activity declined by **-1.2 percent in the US**, -1.7 percent in Japan and Germany-3.9% in Germany.

Trademarks

A trademark can be any word, phrase, symbol, design, or combination of these things that identifies a person or company's goods or services in the marketplace. A trademark is used for goods; a "service mark" is used for services.

Copyrights

Copyrights protect original works of authorship, such as paintings, photographs, musical compositions, sound recordings, computer programs, books, blog posts, movies, architectural works, and plays.
