Top seeded Indian Grandmaster **R Praggnanandhaa** and **P V Nandhidhaa** won the titles in the Open and women's sections respectively in the Asian Continental Chess championship held in **New Delhi**.

The Asian Continental Chess Championship was held in **New Delhi** from 26 October to 3 November 2022.

R Praggnanandhaa remained unbeaten in the tournament and has also qualified for the **FIDE World Chess cup** to be held in 2023.

The international chess governing body FIDE has not yet announced the date and place of the World Chess Cup 2023.

India's Shubi Gupta and A Charvi won the girls under-12 and under-8 sections respectively in the <u>FIDE</u> World Cadets Chess Championship .

A.Charvi of Karnataka won the gold medal in the U-8 girls event with nine points

Under -8 boys events

Safin Safarullakhan of Kerala won the **bronze medal** in the under-8 boy category . The gold medal was won by France's Marc Llari and the silver was won by Russian Sav Shogdzhiev Roman.
