1. India's Praggnanandhaa and Nandhidhaa wins the Asian Continental Chess championship (Nov. 4, 2022)

Asian Continental Chess championship

Top seeded Indian Grandmaster **R Praggnanandhaa** and **P V Nandhidhaa** won the titles in the Open and women's sections respectively in the Asian Continental Chess championship held in **New Delhi**.

The Asian Continental Chess Championship was held in **New Delhi** from 26 October to 3 November 2022.

R Praggnanandhaa remained unbeaten in the tournament and has also qualified for the **FIDE World Chess cup** to be held in 2023.

The international chess governing body FIDE has not yet announced the date and place of the World Chess Cup 2023.

2. Shubi Gupta, Charvi wins the U-12 and U-8 section title at the FIDE World Cadets Chess Championship (Sept. 28, 2022)

India's Shubi Gupta and A Charvi won the girls under-12 and under-8 sections respectively in the **FIDE** World Cadets Chess Championship .

The FIDE World Cadets Chess Championship was held in Batumi, Georgia from 16 September to 27 September 2022.

Medal winners of India

Under -12 Girls events

Shubhi Gupta, of Uttar Pradesh scored 8.5 points from 11 rounds to claim the **gold medal** in the under-12 event.

Under 8 Girls event

A.Charvi of Karnataka won the **gold medal** in the U-8 girls event with nine points

Under -8 boys events

Safin Safarullakhan of Kerala won the **bronze medal** in the under-8 boy category . The gold medal was won by France's Marc Llari and the silver was won by Russian Sav Shogdzhev Roman.
