Gir is the **only sanctuary for Asiatic lions** in the world.

World's highest polling station located in the **Tashigang village** of the Lahaul Spiti constituency recorded a turnout of 98.08% on 12 November 2022. The Tashigang village at an altitude of 15,256 feet, has 52 registered voters and 51 voted.

In an area where temperatures can dip to minus 16 degrees Celsius, a 100 percent turnout had been recorded during the 2019 **Mandi Lok Sabha** bye-election.

The voting to elect the 14th <u>Himachal Pradesh</u> legislative Assembly was held on 12 November 2022. The Himachal Pradesh Legislative Assembly has 68 seats.

The counting of votes will be taken up on 8 December along with the Gujarat Legislative Assembly and the process will be completed by 10 December 2022.

The election to constitute 15th <u>Gujarat Legislative Assembly</u> will be held on 1st and 5th of December 2022.
