The award is a testament to India's commitment to its Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs), particularly Goal 5 (Gender Equality) and Goal 9 (Industry, Innovation and Infrastructure).

India's Performance in the Global Gender Gap Index (GGGI) 2022

- India's performance in the GGGI 2022 has improved significantly, moving up 11 places to 134th position, up from 145th in 2021. This is a commendable achievement, especially considering the global challenges faced during the pandemic.
- The improvement is primarily driven by India's progress in the 'Economic Participation of Women' and 'Work-life Balance' categories. - India's score in the GGGI 2022 is 73.3, up from 71.4 in 2021. This score is a reflection of the government's commitment to gender equality and women's empowerment.
